Dry, Fresh and Crisp

Kudu Plains Chenin Blanc	125ml	3.15
<i>South Africa</i>	175ml	4.50
This is a Chenin Blanc with bags of character! Firstly there’s the alcohol, plenty of it and secondly the rich rounded apricot, pear, guava and vanilla flavours. Very rich on the palate so best to have with food!	Bottle	18.50

Gable View Sauvignon Blanc	125ml	3.35
<i>South Africa</i>	175ml	4.75
Fact! South Africa make really good Sauvignon Blanc and is gloriously received especially when it doesn’t cost an arm and a leg, like this one. Less tropical and lighter than Marlborough it will be perfect for drowning your sorrows over a plate of fish and chips.	Bottle	18.50

Tuffolo Gavi	125ml	4.35
<i>Italy</i>	175ml	5.85
Forget Pinot Grigio, try this! Where other Italian iconic 70’s throwback wines have lost their ways Gavi has gone from strength to strength. Refreshingly floral with a dry citrus mouthfeel. Gavi has real Hollywood star apeal, so much so Cod would jump out the sea and say eat me with a bottle of this.	Bottle	24.00

Satellite Sauvignon Blanc	125ml	4.50
<i>New Zealand</i>	175ml	6.25
Aptly named because of the area in Marlborough where the wine is produced. Not typical of modern Marlborough Savvie because the wine has some age to it but it still delivers a gob full of asparagus, gooseberry and tropical fruit!	Bottle	25.00

Fruity and Rich

The Paddock Chardonnay	125ml	3.25
<i>Australia</i>	175ml	4.25
Don’t worry this is un-oaked Chardonnay, so all the creamy, toasty oak flavours are stripped away and you are left with a juicy sun-packed Oz wine exotic tropical flavours, pineapple, peach and melon. All healthy stuff... except for the alcohol that is!!	Bottle	17.50

The Spee’wah Crooked Mick	125ml	3.65
Pinot Grigio	175ml	5.25
<i>Australia</i>	Bottle	20.00
Named after the Aussie legend, who was a bit like Desperate Dan, he ate two sheep for lunch and used small trees for tooth picks... Yeh! Right! Nothing mythical about the wine though, peachy fresh with a sexy drizzle of lemons, limes and almonds on the finish!		

Garzon Albariño	125ml	4.00
<i>Uruguay</i>	175ml	6.00
This Albarino from Garzón is a great export from Uruguay, with fresh floral notes and complex flavours of apricot and pear, balanced with minerality. In the mouth it is structured with good natural acidity that makes it a perfect companion to any meal.	Bottle	23.00

Cuatro Rayas Verdejo	125ml	4.00
<i>Spain</i>	175ml	5.50
Full flavoured and powerful but well balanced with a silky texture and wonderful length. The average vine is 80 years old in these vinyards giving great depth of flavour and complexity.	Bottle	22.00

Aromatic and Intense

Mamora Vermentino di Sardegna	125ml	4.35
<i>Italy</i>	175ml	5.85
Rich bouquet with a hint of bitter almond, mineral and zest. Vermentino as a grape variety is now outselling Pinot Grigio in Italy 2 to 1. Get on the band waggon before it all goes!	Bottle	24.00

Picpoul de Pinet, La Cote Flamenc	125ml	3.50
<i>France</i>	175ml	5.00
Drier than Ghandi’s flip flop, Picpoul is the modern mans Muscadet and very hip at the moment! It’s lemony fresh and flinty dry but with very balanced characters. Fish is the order of the day here but equally good slurped on it’s own when the sun eventually shows it’s face.	Bottle	20.00

Viognier de l’Hospitalet IGP d’Oc	Bottle	22.00
<i>France</i>		
A delightful wine with an appealing spicy, floral and peachy nose. It is rich and ripe in the mouth yet has subtle apricot notes overlaid with a touch of spice and delicate oaky nuances.		

Kung Fu Girl Riesling	Bottle	27.00
<i>USA</i>		
There is no romantic Martial Arts story here, just the result of a Motley Crew lookalike ex-roadie come winemaker who spent far too much time standing next to the speaker stack smoking herbal cigarettes. Charles Smith is a colourful character and so is his signature wine, lush, seductive and aromatic. It is perfect with food with a sweet chilli kick!		

Classic and Complex

Xanadu Exmoor Drive Chardonnay	Bottle	26.00
<i>Australia</i>		
Only 35% of the wine sees any oak which gives a s oft vanilla and spice depth to the pear and citrus fruit. This is a great example of how well oak can be used to create great Chardonnay without it being a dominant characteristic. Get involved people.		

Chablis, Domaine des Marronniers,	Bottle	29.00

<i>Burgundy, France</i>		
Brilliant benchmark Chablis with clean, incisive Chardonnay fruit: green apples, hints of honey, lemon & limes, stony minerality and just a whisper of richness behind. No oak, just a pure Chablis style.		

Sancerre Les Chailloux	Bottle	30.00
Domaine Fouassier		
<i>Loire Valley, France</i>		
Top notch Sancerre, with a nose of pear, honey, acacia flower and a little touch of grapefruit. Well balanced with a stone and citrus finish.		

Pouilly Fuisse Domaine Trouillet		32.00
<i>Burgundy, France</i>		
Elegant aromas: mineral notes, almond and hazelnut, grapefruit, peaches, acacia, buttered brioche and honey. An opulent and rich texture packed full of flavour and elegance.

Simple, Easy and Fresh

Finca Valero Tempranillo Garnacha	125ml	3.15

This is a soft, fruity, easy going red with bags of dark berry fruit and just a twist of pepper on the finish.	Bottle	18.50

A really good blend of two classic French varieties that often don’t really work together. It’s a lovely reminder of sunnier times skipping around the south of France without a care in the world. Cherry and plum, rosemary and thyme, pepper and spice all in one bottle.	Bottle	18.50

<i>Chile</i>	175ml	4.90
Ultra smooth, juicy Merlot with jammy plum, blackberry and damson fruit served up with lashings of mocha coffee and chocolate. Chile keeps producing these amazing value wines that are just a delight to drink.	Bottle	19.00

Macon Rouge Domaine Dupre	Bottle	26.00
<i>Burgundy, France</i>		
Refreshing flavours of red cherry, strawberry and a touch of dark candied raspberry. For those looking for a lighter style of red. The Gamay variety offers bright and clean fruit character while remaining smooth and soft.		

Full of Fruit

Legato Nero d’Avola	125ml	3.75
<i>Italy</i>	175ml	5.25
Full-bodied, with flavours of mature red fruits, dried prunes and earthy herbs. The tannins are soft and smooth, giving this wine a velvety mouthfeel. Some very modern Sicilian winemaking brings this wonderful grape bang up to date.	Bottle	19.50

<i>Australia</i>	175ml	4.90
This is a wine that truly delivers. Aromas of your grans fruitcake, dark chocolate and liquorice lead to explosive jammy, blackberry and mint flavours. Subtle hints of spice are a gentle reminder of the grape.	Bottle	19.00

Barbera, Riva Leone	Bottle	19.50
<i>Italy</i>		
This hails from Piedmont (Barolo country) and is a real gem. It is modern Italian winemaking, ready to drink once you pull the cork and not like chewing one of your dads old wellies. It’s dry, medium bodied with good fruit and refreshing acidity on the finish - Great with food, great without!		

Lagrimas de Graciano	125ml	4.25
<i>Rioja, Spain</i>	175ml	5.95
As Oliver Hardy famously muttered, Mmm, Mmm, Mmm! There’s Rioja and then there’s this Rioja with attitude and style, made with Graciano (which can be horribly expensive) not Tempranillo. It’s a butch glassful of spicy cherry and raspberry - Hearty food needed here; duck, cassoulet, proper sausages!	Bottle	24.50

Rich and Smooth

Stone Barn Cabernet Sauvignon	125ml	3.75
<i>USA</i>	175ml	5.25
Fruit forward style with hints of ripe cherry, blueberry and blackberry. A lovely soft accessible wine with a dash of vanilla from new French and American oak.	Bottle	19.50

Intense and complex aromas, some ripe dark berries, blackcurrant, plums, black pepper with hints of sweet spices. Soft tannins with a firm structure. Elegant subtle spices and vanilla notes from time spent in oak. A great match for spicy food!

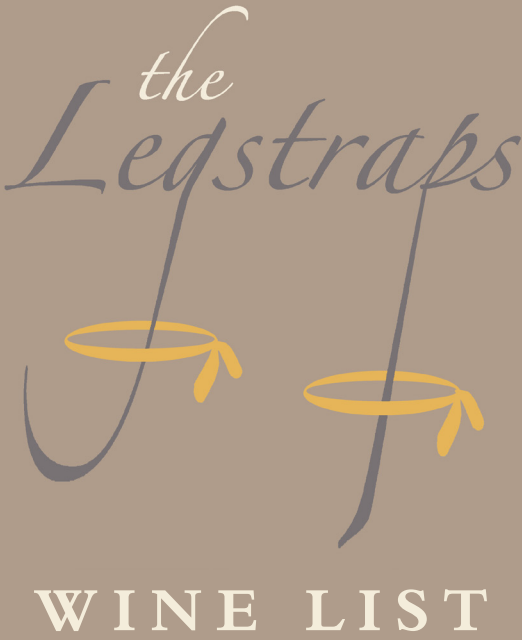
Sweet Wine
