Pétrus - Bordeaux, France, 2006

£5000.00

One of the world's rarest wines, Petrus has truly become an icon of its time under Christian Moueix. The vineyard of just 11½ hectares is located on a plateau in the highest part of Pomerol, the Merlot vines flourishing in the famous blue clay soils. The vines are planted for no less than 70 years, giving extraordinary concentration within the fruit. The grapes are harvested by hand, only in the afternoons when all dew has evaporated in order not to risk any dilution to this intense concentration. The wines are considered approachable after 10 years in bottle: the 2006 vintage is now drinking exceptionally well.

Bolgheri Sassicaia, Tenuta San Guido - Bolgheri, Italy, 2021

£600.00

Sassicaia is today one of the world's most sought-after wines. Mario Incisa della Rocchetta began planting the Bordeaux varietals Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot in Bolgheri on the Tuscan coast, an area of land that had previously been thought to be unsuitable for growing vines. Within the deeply conservative 1960's Tuscan wine-making world this was a radical, even inflammatory, move. So was born the first Super Tuscan. The name Sassicaia means "place of many stones" and the gravel soils have been compared to those of Medoc. Regarded now as one of the world's greatest Cabernet Sauvignon wines, Sassicaia recently made history by being the first single wine to be granted its own DOC. The wines of Sassicaia combine intense notes of cassis and cedar, with extraordinary power and length.

Toscana IGT "Tignanello", Marchesi Antinori - Tuscany, Italy, 2019

£450.00

Antinori is the most famous name in Italian wine and the influence of Piero Antinori in the last 25 years has been nothing short of revolutionary. It's a fair statement to say they created the first Super Tuscan. Antinori's flagship wine, Tignanello, first appeared in 1971 and caused a sensation by its use of Cabernet Sauvignon in a Sangiovese blend and with its practice of ageing in small French barriques. Antinori was accused of vinous treachery and treason but soon barrique-aged blends of Sangiovese and Cabernet began appearing all across Tuscany. The Sangiovese dominates on the nose with notes of grilled meats and Morello cherries. These are echoed on the palate, reminiscent of great Chianti Classico, before the blackcurrant comes in towards the finish to remind you that the Cabernets are there. Great acidity and full, but soft tannins indicate that this will drink relatively early, but has at least a decade of life ahead of it. Another delicious 'Tig' from the team at Antinori.

Chateau Palmer 3ème Cru Classé- Margaux, France, 1989

£810.00

Dating back to the 17th century, Chateau Palmer took its name from Englishman Charles Palmer who purchased the Estate in 1814. The 66 hectare property is now owned by two Bordeaux negotiant families – Sichel and Mähler-Besse, under the charismatic leadership of oenologist Thomas Duroux. Situated not far from the village of Margaux, the vines grow overlooking the Gironde Estuary in a mixture of gravel, sand and clay soils. Since 2008 the estate has become fully biodynamic and the wines share their home with grazing animals and complementary plants. 1989 is one of the great vintages of Château Palmer, a perfectly balanced and exquisitely detailed blend of 52% Cabernet Sauvignon, 41% Merlot, 6% Petit Verdot and 1% Cabernet Franc. It is a wine that can be described as cerebral. The wines are fleshy, full-bodied and powerful yet supple. The tannins are ripe and integrated.

Grands-Echezeaux Grand Cru Joseph Drouhin - Burgundy, France, 2017

The name comes from "cheza" (plural "chezeaux"); a hamlet. The monks of Citeaux, who already owned Clos Vougeot, coveted the Musigny vineyard but were never able to acquire it. They put all their hopes instead on Grands-Echezeaux so as to become the rival of the prestigious Musigny. Peerless Burgundy, packed with cherries, dark chocolate and cocoa bean, increasingly fragrant with truffle, undergrowth and leather as it ages.

Dominus Estate - Napa Valley, USA, 2005

£750.00

The reputation of Christian Moueix as one of the world's leading winemakers is based as much on the wines of Dominus as Petrus. His longstanding relationship with the West Coast began in the 1960s as a student studying abroad. Despite returning home to run the family vineyards in Bordeaux, his affection for Napa was undimmed, returning to take full control over the famous Napanook vineyard in the mid-Nineties. The 2005 is a classic Bordeaux blend of 92% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc and 3% Petit Verdot. This is the blessed union of French savoir-faire and Napa fruit purity. Powerful flavours of earth, blackcurrant, sweet black cherry and incense, with the oak firmly pushed into the background, are the rewards of this great "Terroir" wine which is now hitting its prime.

Magnum

Cabernet Sauvignon "Cask 23", Stags Leap - Napa Valley, USA, 2016

Cabernet Sauvignon grapes from two top vineyards make for a wine spilling over with dark berries and strawberries and fragrant with cedar, cocoa and spice, with a trace of white truffle on the finish. Fruit was handpicked in the early hours of the morning before undergoing fermentation in 100% stainless steel tanks. Each parcel of grapes was vinified and aged separately in small French oak barrels for a period of 21 months. This allowed the characteristics of each block to develop and to take on notes of subtle spice.

Clos St Hune by Maison Trimbach is one of the most legendary dry Rieslings in the world. This single-vineyard expression is sourced from the Grand Cru Rosacker site, characterised by its limestone and clay soils, which contribute to the wine's distinctive minerality. The bouquet features notes of almonds, citrus and subtle spices, with a refreshing acidity on the palate that balances its richness. Founded in 1626, Trimbach has a longstanding reputation for producing high-quality Rieslings.

Concentrated aromas and flavours of dried citrus, peaches and passion fruit. Toasty notes are reminiscent of a vintage Champagne without the bubbles. It has a creamy finish that features rich, spicy notes. Powerful and elegant.

Château d'Yquem, Sauternes Premier Cru Supérieur - Bordeaux, France, 2009

£900.00

Yquem is located on the highest hill in Sauternes and enjoys the best growing conditions in the whole appellation. The 110-hectare vineyard is planted with 80% Sémillon and 20% Sauvignon Blanc. Only fully botrytized fruit is picked by the 150 highly skilled pickers and yields are so low that each vine produces only one glass of wine. Yquem is fermented in oak barrels (100% new) and is left in barriques to mature for up to 36 months. Intensely opulent when young, Yquem develops an extraordinary complexity and exotic richness when fully mature, with the best vintages lasting for over 50 years. With a refined fragrance of honeysuckle, citrus peel, and barley sugar, this has very elegant sweetness on the palate but it is not at all blowsy, with good acidity to provide excellent balancing freshness. Beautifully harmonious and truly fine, with a very long finish.

Ruby, cherry red tones gently fading at edges. Attractive fresh fruit and spice bouquet. Intense; surprisingly youthful. An elegant, nicely weighted and balanced wine. Firm full fruit flavours with a freshness that carries on through to the finish..

Intense ruby colour, now just beginning to open out. Rich, complete, multidimensional nose, displaying elements of both youth and maturity. 349 *Saperavi, Bedoba - Kakheti, Georgia (Ve)*

£52.00

Bedoba, which translates to 'Day of Luck', is a Georgian winery primarily dedicated to making wines from the country's indigenous Saperavi grape, partially vinified in traditional qvevri vessels. The nose opens with a powerful savoury-spicy bouquet of blackberries, herbs, flowers and black pepper. The palate has a creamy, juicy texture, ripe tannins and black fruit flavours.

350 *Chateau Musar - Bekaa Valley, Lebanon (Ve)*

Blood red in colour with a rich, fragrant fruit nose; mulberries, black cherries, plums with a hint of mocha. The palate is very intense and concentrated, it's full of volume and characterised by forest and black fruits with elegant spice. The tannins are soft and juicy and it has a lengthy finish.
