3 COURSE WINE PAIRING FOR £25

VOLCANIC

- 1 **Etna Rosso DOC, Italy, Nerello Mascalese - 2020** Bottle £52
175ml £12.5 250ml £17.5 Carafe £36
Situated in the heart of Etna viticulture. It comes from the Ancient grape variety Nerello Mascalese and perfectly reflects the unique and splendid terroir of Etna. A soft red wine with flesh and structure. Very typical of the area with notes of plums, raspberries and green tomato leaves

WARM REDS

- 1 **Sierra Cantabria, Seleccion, Spain, Rioja – 2019** Bottle £40.5
175ml £9.5 250ml £13 Carafe £26
This wine displays black cherry, blackberry and redcurrant aromas, with spicy and floral touches. On the palate it is balanced, approachable, fresh and nicely-proportioned, with a surprisingly long finish
- 2 **De Martino Estate, Merlot, Chile – 2019** Bottle £38
175ml £9.5 250ml £13 Carafe £26
Ripe dark and red berry fruit aromatics including blueberries and raspberries, combined with a plummy and spicy note.
- 3 **Meinert Wines Printer's Ink, Pinotage South Africa – 2018** Bottle £46.5
175ml £11.5 250ml £15.5 Carafe £31
Pinotage is Pinot Noir crossed with Cinsault, and this wine tastes exactly like that - it has the beautiful hedgerow fruit of Pinot Noir, seasoned with the liquorice and star anise spice of Cinsault. Caressing the palate with Pinot's seductive silky softness, it has just a touch more roundness and body.
- 4 **Château La Pointe Bouquey, St. Émilion, Bordeaux, France – 2019** Bottle £45
175ml £11.5 250ml £15.5 Carafe £31
Just as a Bordeaux should be, smooth, expressive with a juicy soft texture. A fruity combination of blackcurrant and blueberries all held together with an abundance of silky tannins.

WHITE WINE

- 1 **Cannonball, Chardonnay, California - 2020** Bottle £45
175ml £11 250ml £15.5 Carafe £31
Sophisticated nose of lemon curd, peaches, and a hint of pie crust. On the palate, zippy stone fruit and tropical notes, pineapple and soft vanilla bean on the finish.
- 2 **Trimbach, France, Riesling – 2019** Bottle £49.5
175ml £12 250ml £16.5 Carafe £33
This is absolutely classic dry Riesling with tangy lime pith and aromatic beeswax character. Fine balance and texture on the palate, with typical Trimbach understated elegance. Still youthful and fresh, it is just starting to show hints of matured complexity. Delicious now, it will continue to

- 3 **DO Rias Baixas, Mar de Frades, Atlántico Albarino, Spain - 2021** Bottle £47.5
175ml £11.5 250ml £16 Carafe £32
Mango, pineapple and lychees on the nose together with wild flowers and notes of eucalyptus. Bright, fresh and vivacious on the palate, the tropical fruit flavours are lifted by a streak of Atlantic-coast salinity.
- 4 **Knightor Carpe Diem, Cornwall, England** Bottle £47.5
175ml £11.5 250ml £16 Carafe £32
It is delicate, lively and fresh with aromas of elderflower, nettle and apple. Crisp and clean on the palate with plenty of fruit flavours and a long tangy

SOMETHING SWEET

- 1 **Tokaji Katinka, Hungry - 2018** 50ml £7 100ml £13.5
Light golden straw in colour, medium-bodied, reflecting its 12 months in barriques with appealing vanilla and caramel notes. Showing a light botrytis influence. Lightly sweet, showing dried orange, tobacco and white chocolate on a lightly spicy background. Just the right hints of complexity and elegance. Exquisite length. Delicious.
- 2 **Vintage Fortified Shiraz, d'Arenberg, Australia - 2018** 50ml £6.5 100ml £12
Beautiful perfume with blackberry, blueberry and middle eastern saffron spice on the nose. Dusty, earthy aromas give way to layers of aniseed and black olive. The palate beautifully follows the nose; mouth filling, generous, and not overtly sweet.
