Big, Generous, Everest like Reds

Bodega Familia Cassone, Siete Cuchillos Malbec Bottle

Mendoza, Argentina, 2018

Malbec, originally from Cahors in France but now Argentina's unique calling card in the wine world. Big, rich, dark fruits cut through with smoke and spice.

Baron de Ley, Reserva Tempranillo, Grenache €49.00
Rioja, Spain, 2014

This red has been the wine of choice for very special events here - a wine that delivers every time.

D'Arenberg, 'The Footbolt' Shiraz €52.00
Mc Laren Vale, South Australia, 2018

"Lovely smooth clean fruits that get better and better as the bottle empties. A very stylish all-rounder to put alongside red meats and cheese." John Wilson, Irish Times

Château Puynard, 'The Steps' €60.00
Blaye, Bordeaux, 2018

Owned by a couple from Cavan. But nothing mean here. Big rich, dark fruits with hints of spice and wood.

Esporão, Reserva Tinto €66.00
Alentejo, Portugal, 2018

A serious and delicious Portuguese red wine. Lots of rich, ripe fruit kept in check with hints coffee, mint, pepper, clove and a brush of tannin

**Domaine des Peres de L'Eglise,
Le Calice de St Pierre** €75.00
Châteauneuf du Pape, 2016

Niece Laetia and Uncle Serge make classic CdP wines. Powerful, dark cherries and baked strawberries, hints of licourice, lavender and cinnamon all kept in check with some gentle tannins.

Delas Frères, 'Domaine des Grand Chemins' €95.00
Crozes-Hermitage, 2016

Another Rhone Valley classic, but very different to the CdP above. 100% Syrah here, dense, dark red fruits with savoury hints of bacon, smoke, pepper and dark chocolate. Did someone order the steak?

Penfolds, Bin 389 Cabernet Shiraz €190.00
South Australia, 2018

Affectionately known as 'Baby Grange'. (But only a baby in relation to that most famous Penfold's wine). Bin 389, a classic Australian blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz, is a seriously grown up wine.
