Pinot Noir Chardonnay. A charmingly aromatic & refreshing Organic Chilean sparkling made in the traditional method (bottle fermented).

White

Piquepoul Rousanne, Ordinal 2021, France £31
A 50/50% split of Picpoul & Roussanne, & what a blend! You get the typical citrusy, mineral Picpoul with a slightly rounded edge from the aromatic Roussanne.

Old Vine Palomino, Strange Kompanjie 2022, S.Africa (Vgn) £35
Made from vines planted in 1977, this Palomino is fresh with zesty fruit, fennel & a herbaceous edge. Great with asparagus & fish.

Rose

Chateau l'Ermite d'Auzan Rose, Nimes 2021, France (Vgn, Org) £35
Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre. Delicious, modern, 'Organic' Southern French Rose from the Costieres de Nimes. Salmon pink, dry, with raspberry & cranberry fruits, refreshing acidity & a crisp, mineral finish.

On the palate, layers of complexity show an opulence of fruit, smoothly integrated with the core tannins of a slightly cooler growing season.
