



## WHITE WINES

### Ombrellino, Italy

Expect a refreshing palate of stone fruit and citrus. It's an exceptional match for seafood.

### Five Foot Track, Australia

Soft and buttery with a smooth mouthfeel and a rich, fruity finish

### Vina Carrasco, Chile

Youthful, lively & fresh with herbal tropical notes, followed by a zesty citrus palate.

### Picpoul Plo d'Isabelle

A crisp, zesty wine made from the rare Picpoul grape. Vibrant green apple fruit with a refreshingly dry and acidic finish.

### Fernlands, Marlborough

A vibrant & perfectly-balanced wine with a fruit-driven palate with a lasting & refreshing finish, encapsulating what 'Marlborough' does best

### Nero Oro Grillo, Sicily

Grillo is a wonderfully aromatic, and distinctly Italian, white grape. It's the perfect base for this style of wine making. Honeyed and dried fruity, it also has the fresh zing of grapefruit.

### Lyrarakis Assyrtiko

Dive into Greek wine with this bone dry, extremely fresh white. Known as 'Crete's answer to Chablis', it is fragrant with wild aromas of meadow flower and yellow orchard minerality and green apple.

### Casal de Ventozela, Alvarinho

The Ferreira Cortinhas family have made exceptional wine at Casal de Ventozela since 1978, but it wasn't until 2012 that they perfected their style of Alvarinho and this is a reward of their patience. This is complex and full-bodied, yet remarkably dry and refreshing with notes of apricot, peach and well-integrated oak.

### Macon-Villages La Cave d'Aze

This simple, fruity wine is fresh and cool with acidity that brings out citrus and kiwi fruits. It's a refreshing wine to drink instantly.

### King Stag, Chardonnay

The majestic, cool-climate Chardonnay exudes a complex aroma of white peach, orange blossom and a touch of French oak, setting a back-drop for crisp acidity and an agile finish. Its superb balance and refined character make this wine a noble presence, whether enjoyed with food or simply relished on its own.

### La Toledana, Gavi di Gavi

From one of the oldest standing Genoese noble houses, this crisp, fresh and citrusy wine is deliciously refreshing and aromatic, with hints of white peaches and honey.

### Albarino Martin Codax, Rias Baixas

The grapes are grown in terrifyingly steep amphitheatres overlooking the waves. Peachy, citrusy and fresh, it's the perfect seaside wine, made for seafood.

### E Bonneville Chablis

This wine is fresh and harmonious, with nicely focused green fruit character and an elegant mineral texture.

## RED WINES

### Five Foot Track, Australia

A soft fruity red with ripe berry fruit and gentle pepper and spice flavours.

### Vina Carrasco, Chile

On the nose rich notes of plum and blackberries lifted by Chocolate & Mocha. Silky yet structured fruit flavours.

### Riscos, Colchagua Valley, Chile

Using some of the ripest Malbec grapes to produce this deeply coloured wine with a silky soft texture and rich spicy dark fruit flavours

### Marques del Postulado, Spain

Dark Cherry with purplish hues. Intense aroma recalling juice & red berries. On the palate displays refreshing, rich & fruity flavour with a persistent finish.

### St Desir, South of France

Showing violets and sweet red berries on the nose the palate is light, velvety and intricate, with integrated toasted notes.

### Baussac, France

Deep and inky red in colour, this wine is crammed with black cherry fruit, lifted by subtle vanilla aromas from a touch of oak ageing.

### Apericena Appassimento

Rich, velvety and bold, this red is the prime example of luscious appassimento wine made from two famed Italian grapes: Primitivo and Negroamaro. The deeply concentrated flavours of red fruit, spice and dried berries will match harmoniously with red meats and Italian cuisine.

### Catena, Mendoza, Argentina

Elegantly structured, showing ripe blackberry and blackcurrant fruit flavours and plenty of peppery spice. The finish has distinct chocolate notes and crisp, refreshing acidity.

### St. Michelle Vineyards, Columbia Valley

Cabernet Sauvignon is a standout variety from Washington, with silky tannins, rich complexity and concentrated fruit. That's why our Columbia Valley Cabernet is the perfect choice to carry the nostalgic banner of our 50th anniversary.

### Chateau Grand Faurie La Rose/07

The area has St. Emilion's trademark sand and limestone soils. A medium-bodied claret, with a pleasantly spicy and mature nose, with hints of leather and clove against a backdrop of bramble and dried prune fruit, framed by fine-grained tannins on the palate.

### The Chocolate Block, Western Cape

An earthy, rustic nose gives up aromas of leather, earth and spices over a backdrop of blackcurrant and ripe raspberry fruit. Harmonious and powerful on the palate, with a cocoa and pepper complexity.

<b>Chapel Down Rose Brut, NV</b> The epitome of an English Rose – delicate and feminine. A delicate rose petal pink in colour with hints of strawberry, blackcurrant and rosehip on the palate and fine persistent bubbles. <b>Veuve Cliquot Rose</b> A relatively recent addition to the Veuve Cliquot stable, this medium bodied rosé is reminiscent of the power and finesse of the non-vintage label, with a soft red-fruit core.				£62

<b>Vistamar Late Harvest, Moscatel</b> Straw yellow in colour, with golden highlights. Aromas of white flowers, peach, apricots and quince carry through to a palate of more ripe stone fruits and dried fig flavours.	<i>Chile</i>	£4.80		£12
<b>Elysium Black Muscat</b> Black Muscat, an under-appreciated Muscat variety, one of the very few black-skinned Muscats. Elysium is Greek for Heaven, a fitting association for this excellent wine made by Andrew Quady. Virtually black in colour, with a rose-like aroma, very intense on the palate and full of fantastic rich velvety fruit.	<i>California</i>			£17
