# WINE LIST

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Losehill House Hotel was built in 1914, originally called 'Moorgate Guest House'. However, we think it opened in 1916. It is likely that opening was delayed by the First World War. Losehill House has ever remained a public building, existing for its guests' enjoyment of the Derbyshire Peaks.

Although late for an 'Arts and Crafts' style building, the architect has perhaps adopted a style with a philosophy that matched the ethos of the charitable organisation that funded the build... Co- operative Holidays Association was founded by Lancashire Church Minister, Thomas Arthur Leonard, in 1891. *"To provide simple and strenuous recreative and educational holidays and to promote friendship and fellowship amid the beauty of the natural world."* Losehill House is one of few purpose-built 'CHA' walking hostels and remained in their ownership late into the 20<sup>th</sup> century. Our now 'Private Dining Room', just past the bar, was once the 'Prayer Room'. There was some disapproval when subsequent owners used it as the hotel's then 'Television Room'.

The hotel was bought by Shearings coach company but had to be closed under their ownership during the 2001 foot and mouth epizootic. Since being sold on, it has been privately owned... Previous owners Barry & Mary redeveloped the building in 2003, including the addition of the Orangery & Swimming Pool. Current owners Paul & Kathryn Roden purchased the hotel in 2007.

We often see guests who visited many years before, remembering their own experiences and the differing guises and atmospheres of the building. Although the layout of the 'House' has been revised, the site retains a rich social history and the rich

personal histories of the people who have visited.

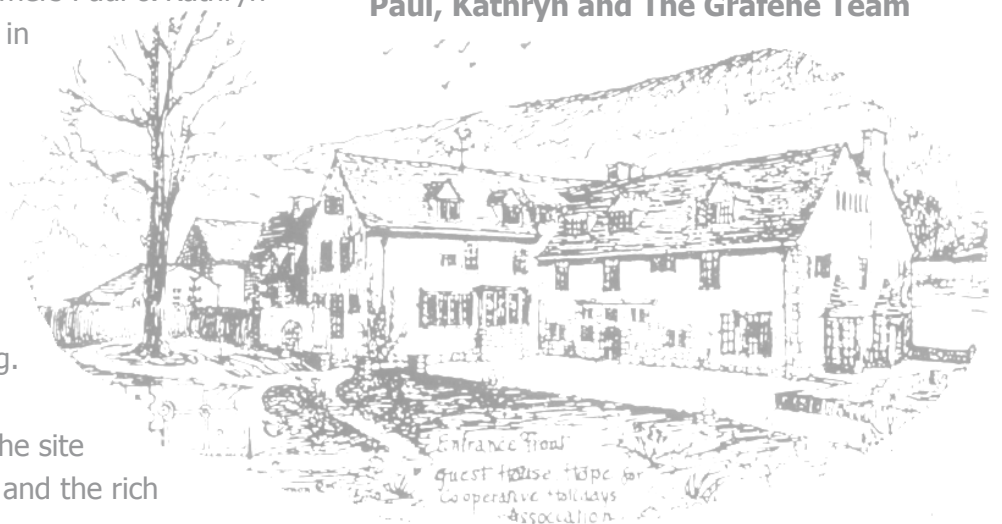
The current name comes from the hillside on which we are situated: Lose Hill. Conversely, the hill in view across the valley is called Win Hill. It is suggested that there was once a battle in the area; situating the soldiers of the Kings of Mercia & Wessex from what is now known as 'Lose Hill' against the soldiers of the King of Northumbria from what is now known as 'Win Hill'.

In 2016, Paul and Kathryn opened a new restaurant in central Manchester with a focus on creative British dining. It was named Grafene, inspired by graphene, an allotrope of carbon, isolated in single-atom depth, almost charge-neutral layers, in 2004 at the University of Manchester. In 2019, Grafene relocated into Losehill House Hotel's orangery restaurant.

To make our wine index more accessible to our valued guests, we have listed our whites and reds into categories of 'drinking style'. As wine taste is nearly always a subjective experience and there are seldom absolutes when categorising style, we understand that some individual wines may straddle more than one style category. We hope that you enjoy our selection and we welcome your comments and feedback.

# SPARKLING

**101 Prosecco Spumantizzato** Imperativo! Veneto, Italy

Grapes: 100% Glera, sometimes referred to as 'Prosecco!' N.V. 11% **V** £30.00  
Refreshing and crisp, with fine bubbles and a delicate, fruity aroma.

**102 Syn Rouge** Leconfield Estate Coonawarra, South Australia

Grapes: 100% Shiraz N.V. 12% £35.00  
Sparkling red is a unique favourite of the Australian wine scene. Having been taken more seriously than it traditionally has in Europe, these wines express qualities that would be expected of a quality still red. Matured in oak before being endowed with a natural effervescence via a secondary fermentation, this example is beautifully balanced and creamy, exhibiting cherry flavours and a vibrant raspberry nose, followed by a soft, cleansing acidity to the finish.

**103 Maria Gomes Espumante** Luis Pato Regional Beiras, Portugal

Grapes: 95% Maria Gomes and 5% Sercialinho N.V. 12.5% £35.00  
The grapes were first fermented in stainless steel vats under controlled temperature for two weeks. Secondary fermentation occurs inside the bottle to retain the fresh flavours of flowers and fruits. This dry, sparkling white wine has a bouquet of grapefruit, lemon and pineapple with faint biscuit character. Young-at-heart bubbly with good acidity and mineral freshness in the finish.

**104 Crémant de Loire Rosé** Baumard 'Carte Corail' Loire, France

Grapes: 100% Cabernet Franc N.V. 12.5% **Vt** £43.00  
A very fine, pale pink hue. The nose is enticing, full of peachy fresh fruit, nuanced with early tinges of honeycomb and some red fruits, sprinkled with mint. Absolutely packed with vivacious fruits held up by a lively acidity. Delicious hints of strawberry and cream, sprinkled with notes of black pepper on the palate. Harmonious and polished, this beautifully crafted sparkling wine has a vibrant, lively mousse.

**105 Crémant d'Alsace** Clément Klur Alsace, France

Grapes: 50% Pinot Blanc and 50% Pinot Auxerrois N.V. 12.5% **VOS** £50.00  
An astonishingly fruity nose of apple with hints of brioche. Citrus fruits and green apple complement the fine bouquet. Fruity and balanced, with fine bubbles. The finish is long, dry and soft. Wine production in the terroir goes back to the seventeenth century, however, the present small, family-run estate was founded in 1999. Using biodynamic practices and following a natural approach to cultivation and ecology. *No Added Sulphites.*

**106 Single Vineyard Rosé** Exton Park Hampshire, England

Grapes: 70% Pinot Noir and 30% Pinot Meunier N.V. 11.5% £55.00  
The 55-acre single-vineyard of this award-winning English wine producer is planted on the rolling chalk slopes of Hampshire's South Downs National Park. The Grapes known for Champagne are known to produce elegant wine when grown in chalk soils, and with a cool, northerly climate, the estate is able to produce some of the finest, award-winning wines in England. This is a sparkling pale pink 'Britagne' with delicate floral fruit flavours, yet with a surprising depth of fruit.



# CHAMPAGNE

**107 Brut Royale** Pommery Champagne, France

35% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir and 30% Pinot Meunier N.V. 12.5% **V** £60.00

Vivacious, fresh and fine, with a nose of white flowers and citrus. Initial notes of berries on the palate with a harmonious finish. In 1874 Madame Pommery created the very first 'Brut' Champagne, the style that is known today, and Pommery continues to lead the way with its delicate house style. The grapes are sourced from 40 selected crus in the Côte des Blancs and Montagne de Reims.

**108 Brut Rosé** Pommery Champagne, France

50% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir and 10% Pinot Meunier N.V. 12.5% **V** £65.00

A very pale salmon pink. Fruity and fleshy, elegantly robust with a perfect balance of freshness. Although delightful by day, soft lighting of evening is most flattering to Brut Rose's pale colour.

**109 Blanc de Blancs** Pierre Mignon Grand Cru Champagne, France

100% Chardonnay N.V. 12% **V** £75.00

Exuberant hue of pale gold with a bead of bubbles. Aromas of pear and citrus lead on to exotic fruit. Caramel with lightly buttered toast to finish. Refreshing minerality evolving into creamy effervescence.

**110 Cuvée de Madame** Pierre Mignon Millésimée Champagne, France

60% Chardonnay, 30% Pinot Meunier and 10% Pinot Noir 2008 12% £85.00

A vintage Champagne, rich on the nose, with a grand complexity in the mingling nuances of lemon and honey. It is wide and powerful on the mouth. Ideal with canapés or a celebratory dish.

**111 Cuvée Louise** Pommery Champagne, France

60% Chardonnay and 40% Pinot Noir 2002 12.5% £145.00

Ample and fruity on the palate with fresh end-notes of delicate berry. Exquisite.

**112 Dom Pérignon Rosé** Champagne, France

Exclusively low-yield Pinot Noir and Chardonnay 2003 12.5% **V** £350.00

An incredibly rare wine that is considered as the 'ultimate expression' of the wine house's expertise.



## WHITE WINE **Crisp and Mineral**

Within this section, you will find wines that exhibit a zingy freshness. Most often, these wines are dry, light-bodied, mostly unoaked and usually possess crisp levels of acidity. These wines are suitable to pair with white fish, salad and dishes with acidic elements, such as vinaigrettes.

**250 Pinot Grigio** Călușari Timișului, Romania  
Grapes: 100% Pinot Grigio 2018 12% **V** £25.00

Englishman, Philip Cox and his Romanian wife Elvira, have put in a huge amount of work into transforming their land into a modern winemaking haven. The results are outstanding wines that can stand shoulder to shoulder with their peers from around the world. A deliciously fresh, dry white wine with crisp apple and pear fruit. The palate is light, juicy and vibrant with refreshing hints of grapefruit and pineapple.

**216 Casa do Homem** Branco Vinho Verde, Portugal  
Grapes: 90% Loureiro and 10% Arinto 2017 12.5% **V** £28.00

Fruity aroma with floral notes. Piquant citrus and tropical fruits. Vibrant acidity and pleasingly spritz in the mouth, yet still fresh and elegant. Very drinkable and with a crisp finish.

**208 White Dot** Strofilia Peloponnese, Greece  
Grapes: 80% Moschofilero and 20% Roditis 2018 12% **V** £28.00

Pale yellow with aromas of rose petal, lemon blossom and citrus; the palate is characterised by fresh, aromatic fruit, backed by a soft, round textured finish. Moschofilero, an aromatic, pink-purple skinned grape of Greek origin, is grown in the Mantinia region whilst the Roditis is grown in Aigialia. The free-run juices, refrigerated to low-temperatures, are fermented separately before being blended together.

**202 Grüner Veltliner** Weinwurms Weinviertel, Austria  
Grapes: 100% Grüner Veltliner 2018 12.5% £30.00

The family winery Weinwurms is located in the north-eastern part of the Weinviertel, a region influenced by Pannonian climate. Harvest by the hand in the middle of October in small boxes, gentle pressing with pneumatic press, and fermented in stainless tanks at 18 °C. Clear bright citrus yellow with tinges of green. A delightfully refreshing wine that displays green apples and lime, some herbs, and a fine elegant finish.

**260 Estate Riesling** Dr. Loosen Mosel, Germany  
Grapes: 100% Riesling 2018 8.5% £30.00

Made by one of Germany's most famous wine producers - The Dr. Loosen estate has been in the family for over 200 years and possesses some of Germany's most respected and spectacular, steep vineyards, which feature a cool climate and slate soils. This example is medium-dry with easy-drinking light sweetness. Fruity and aromatic with exceptional freshness, flavours of white peach, floral notes and a flinty minerality, typical of the terroir.

**222 Pinot Gris** Acrobat Oregon, U.S. of A.  
Grapes: 100% Pinot Gris 2017 13.5% **Vt** £35.00

Pear, red apple, lemon and rose petal on the nose. Fresh zesty red pear and green apple on the palate with a nice refreshing 'limey' lick of acidity. Medium bodied mouthfeel with a lingering finish. Responsibly grown in the breath-taking hills and valleys of Western Oregon.



**220 Albariño** Lembranzas Rias Baixas, Spain  
Grapes: 100% Albariño 2018 12.5% £33.00

Situated in the north-western region of Galicia, the Rias Baixas region was formally established in 1988 and Albariño has always been at the forefront of winemaking grapes for this coastal region. Lembranzas Albariño is great example of the grape variety. Lemon yellow in colour with hints of citrus fruits followed by notes of apple, pear and dried candied fruits. There is a beautiful mineral note on the generous palate, with the overall impression being one of freshness.

**213 Gavi** Tenuta Olim Bauda Piedmont, Italy  
Grapes: 100% Cortese 2018 12.5% £39.00

Scintillating Gavi, made in the most delicate, low interventionist way. This simple and elegant Gavi from Olim Bauda boasts a stunning bouquet of floral notes and soft citrus fruits. A fresh and dry white wine, the crisp floral notes with hints of underlying minerality, lead through to a piercingly pure finish.

**214 Vermentino** Tenuta Meraviglia Bolgheri, Italy  
Grapes: 100% Vermentino 2018 13.5% £41.00

Scents of flowers, plants, sage, rosemary and thyme. Vineyards, nestled on a hilltop, overlooking the sea produce a wine that embodies the freshness of the Tuscan coast. This elegant white wine delights with its fruity and herbal aromas which have been determined by the sandy, fossil-rich soil.

**201 Arneis** Adelina 'Eternal Return' Adelaide Hills, South Australia  
Grapes: 100% Arneis 2017 13.5% £46.00

Adelina is a small vineyard and rustic winery in the Springfarm subregion of Clare. This wine was created in collaboration with a select vineyard in Woodside, in the Adelaide hills area. These Arneis vines were planted in 1997, to a southerly aspect. This subtle, elegant wine emanates aromas of herbs, almonds and peach. The well-balanced fruit flavours combine with fresh minerality and acidity. The palate is dry with a rich mouth-feel. A crisp pear finish with a long-lasting sweet scent.

**203 'Vines Cross'** Hidden Spring East Sussex, U.K.  
Grapes: 75% Bacchus and 25% Reichensteiner 2015 11% **V** £50.00

A nicely balanced fine English wine with refreshing acidity, showing grapefruit, nettle and lime zest aromas. Vines Cross is light, fresh and dry with a hint of passion fruit on the palate and a lingering finish. Fermented at a low temperature to retain character and volatile aromas. New owners David and Chris have expanded the 30-year old vineyard over a former campsite, having 24,000 vines newly planted. Their hands-on approach to agriculture and production makes their wine ambition very clear.





## WHITE WINE **Aromatic and Zesty**

“Aromatic” white wine styles tend to be naturally pungent; often created from grape varieties with inherent perfumes that shine through, in the glass. In contrast, more neutral” styles of white are often made with grape varieties that possess less natural perfume and sometimes owe more to external influences such as oak barrel ageing and other winemaking techniques. Aromatic styles make ideal partners for dishes with reasonably strong flavours, creating a great foil for spicy dishes or those that have a certain degree of sweetness.

### **204 Viognier**

Mont Rocher

Pays d’Oc, France

Grapes: 100% Viognier

2018 13% **V** £27.00

Honeysuckle and apricot aroma with a rich, almost unctuous palate that is somehow still dry, tangy and refreshing. Indigenous to the South of France and clearly expressing the aromatic varietal typicity.

### **209 Napbor Fehér Cuvée**

St. Andrea

Eger, Hungary

Grapes: Leankya, Zengó, Pinot Blanc, Chardonnay

2017 13% **V** £28.00

Excellent growing conditions with a hot summer and a long, dry, sunny autumn, allow for full ripening potential. The grapes are then hand-harvested and cold-fermented to maximise the full expression of the wine. With flavours of pear and lychee the wine is balanced with a limey citrus finish. This traditionally Hungarian wine is mostly made from nationally local grapes. The primary grape is Leankya, lending the wine a soft, delicate flavour and semi-intense off-dry palate.

### **219 Verdejo**

Bodegas Gotica

Rueda, Spain

Grapes: 100% Verdejo

2018 12.5% £29.00

Gotica makes wines of increasingly good quality. Enticing aromas of fresh limes, white flowers and pineapple abound on the nose. The palate is fresh and layered, with a perfectly integrated balance between fruit and acidity.

### **280 N.Z. Sauvignon Blanc**

Fairhall Downs

Marlborough, New Zealand

Grapes: 100% Sauvignon Blanc

2018 13.5% £34.00

From one of just a handful of Marlborough producers making 100% estate-grown, single-vineyard wines. Filled with ripe passionfruit, guava, nectarine and lime zest flavours. It is concentrated and succulent on the palate, and delivers waves of delicious flavours, wonderfully supported by fine texture and bright acidity. The wine is intense and punchy, while remaining balanced and friendly.

### **212 Pecorino di Chieti**

Collefrisio

Chieti, Abruzzo, Italy

Grapes: 100% Pecorino

2017 13.5% **VO** £38.00

Straw yellow with golden highlights. This white grape variety from the south of Italy is making a welcome come-back. With green tea and peach on the nose, the aromas follow through onto the palate. This wine is firm, dry and mineral in character and unlike any other whites coming out of this part of the country.

### **215 Château Ka**

‘Source Blanche’

Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

60% Sauvignon Blanc 20% Viognier 10% Muscat 10% Chardonnay 2018 14% **Vt** £39.00

An unusual blend of varieties creates this exceptionally satisfying wine. Floral and citrusy with great depth of character.





## 205 Pouilly Fumé

Domaine A. Cailbourdin

Loire Valley, France

Grapes: 100% Sauvignon Blanc

Vines aged between twenty and thirty years are harvested on the best limestone slopes in the appellation. Blessed with southwestern exposure, this cuvée is a true thoroughbred of a distinctive terroir and aromatic expression. Extraordinarily elegant, this wine possesses aromas of fruits (pineapple, citrus, peach) with mineral tones. On the palate, Les Cris is powerful, well structured and very rich. Excellent balance is achieved due to the perfect ripeness of the grapes at harvest.



## WHITE WINE Rich and Rounded

Styles of this category tend to be weightier in body and are ideal for those who prefer fuller, creamier wines. These will usually have undergone some degree of barrel fermentation or ageing and tend to be derived from grape varieties known for their ability to produce rich, mouth-coating wine. Given their structure, they lend themselves to partnering slightly heavier dishes than other styles. Enjoy with risotto, smoked meat, salmon and even pork.

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<b>217 Chenin Blanc</b>	Windmeul	Cape Coastal Region, South Africa
Grapes: 100% Chenin Blanc		2019 12.5% £26.00

Windmeul Kelder, located N.N.E. of Paarl city, takes its name from the historic windmill close to the site of the winery and cellar. This Chenin Blanc has a fresh and fruity nose with tropical fruit. Lees aging has given this wine a full-tasting palate and the quality of the fruit has produced a zesty character.

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<b>270 Chardonnay</b>	Killibinbin 'Shiver'	Langhorne Creek, Australia
Grapes: 100% Chardonnay		2015 14.5% £30.00

This beautiful Chardonnay comes from one of Australia's most famous vineyards, Metala. Much coveted by a number of famous producers, Killibinbin (the owners) make sure that they keep just enough of the best fruit for themselves! The hand-picked fruit is whole-bunch pressed and fermented and in oak barrels (only a very small percentage of which are new). This approach has led to a rich, layered and deliciously textured wine with an alluring, nutty and peachy character.

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<b>210 Lumà Grillo</b>	Cantina Cellaro	Sicily, Italy
Grapes: 100% Grillo		2018 12% £34.00

Produced in a way that is respectful of nature, snails are allowed to proliferate in the vineyards, which supports the surrounding vegetation. Grillo is well suited to the hot, dry Sicilian climate. Nutty, citrus fruit driven nuances. Light and crisp on the nose with an unexpectedly deeper palate and remarkable lasting honey flavour.

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<b>221 Godello</b>	Merayo	Bierzo, Spain
Grapes: 100% Godello		2019 13% £34.00

Crafted from 80+ year old vineyards Merayo possesses an intense nose of green apple, stone fruit and traces of citrus and fennel. Mineral sensations envelop the wine and lend it great complexity. The palate is rounded and rich, without ever losing the sensation of freshness. Ageing on lees affords a creaminess on the finish, enveloping the wine and giving it a silky, velvety texture.

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<b>211 Lugana</b>	'La Rifra'	Lake Garda, Italy
Grapes: 100% Turbiana		2018 13% £36.00

This is a captivating wine from a very small estate run by brothers Luigi and Claudio. The estate is meticulously maintained and has been in family hands for three generations. Made from Turbiana grapes, this intense, impeccably structured wine is a winemaking revelation. Exhibiting layers of stone fruits, a touch of saltiness and background notes of honeydew melon, La Rifra impresses with a creamy and luscious finish.

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<b>206 Defaix Chablis 1<sup>er</sup> Cru</b>	'Côte de Lechet'	Burgundy, France
Grapes: 100% Chardonnay		2017 13% VO £62.00

Fine, brilliant colour. In the aromas, mineral notes are dominant, associated with delicate touches of green apple and citrus fruit (lemon and grapefruit). The mouth-feel is fresh and persistent.

**218 'Cartology'**

Since its inception in 2011, Cartology has lost none of its cachet and the wine they express continues to garner an ever-increasingly great reputation. Made only from a handful of mountain-side mature Chenin Blanc bush-vines, a true masterpiece is created. Enchanting flavours of quince, honey and hazelnut wrap the palate with a superb, sophisticated finish.

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**207 Corton-Charlemagne**

Domaine Nudant

Burgundy, France

Grapes: 100% Chardonnay

Forty-year-old vines grow in white shale soil on the emblematic 'Cortons Hill'. The Corton-Charlemagne is one of the 6 Grands Crus of the Côte de Beaune and is recognised as one of the best white wines in the world. The wine is a beautiful green-gold colour. To the nose, perhaps due to barrel aging, aromas of fresh walnut slowly disappear for a rich and generous taste. Consumed early, delicate touches of honey, dried fruits and even exotic fruits can be enjoyed.



## ROSÉ WINE Light and Refreshing

**403 Solara Rosé** Solara Ville Timișului, Romania  
Grapes: 65% Merlot and 35% Feteasca Neagra 2019 12% **V** £27.00

Englishman, Philip Cox and his Romanian wife Elvira, have put in a huge amount of work into transforming their land into a modern winemaking haven. The results are outstanding wines that can stand shoulder to shoulder with their peers from around the world. Showing flavours of strawberry and red fruits, this pale rosé is crisp, fresh and fruity, with notes of raspberry on the palate.

**405 Pinot Grigio Blush** Dea del Mare Venezia, Italy  
Grapes: 100% Pinot Grigio 2019 12% £25.00

This elegant Pinot Grigio Blush comes from grapes grown in the North-East of Italy. Typical, light copper in colour with delicate aromas of strawberry and raspberry.

**408 'Les Prunes'** Les Filles d'Amalia Valencia, Spain  
Grapes: 100% Mandó 2018 11.5% **VO** £41.00

Pioneers of quality wine from Valencia, Celler del Roure are committed to nurturing and championing the indigenous varieties of the region; notably the Mandó and Verdil grapes, both of which have been on the edge of extinction. Red-skinned Mandó grapes are harvested early to entice fresh and delicate Mediterranean-style flavours. The free-run juice is fermented as it would be to produce a white wine and finished in old, clay underground amphoras for 6 months. The resultant wine is an attractive pale pink. Very refreshing pure fruit with citric flavours and a zinc minerality. Light, fresh and delicate.

## ROSÉ WINE Fruity and Full

**401 Daimon Rosado** Bodegas Tobia Rioja, Spain  
Grapes: 50% Garnacha, 50% Tempranillo 2018 13% £28.00

A bright, clean appearance of attractive and full raspberry pink with blue tones. Intense fruit flavours of strawberry and cherry with elegant floral aromas of rose, orange blossom and fresh mint. The palate is soft, fresh, friendly, unctuous and dry with a refreshing acidity. A perfumed aftertaste of strawberries and white flowers with a long and rounded finish. This wine is full of Atlantic character.

**402 White Zinfandel** Headland's Cove California, U. S. of A.  
Grapes: 100% White Zinfandel 2017 10.5% £27.00

Delicate and refreshing, this White Zinfandel is abundant in fruity aromas reminiscent of summer with flavours of sweet ripe raspberry and strawberry. On the palate, the red fruits mingle with melon and hints of orange zest and sweet spice.

**404 Mas Donis Rosat** Celler de Capçanes Montsant, Catalonia, Spain  
Grapes: 90% Grenache, 5% Syrah and 5% Merlot 2019 13% **O** £29.00

Fresh and aromatic. Vibrant strawberry and raspberry fill the nose, with a hint of herbs and spices. Medium to full bodied, with a glycerine sweetness that brings ripe flavours and a long fruity finish. Match with seafood, fish or chicken.

**407 Touraine Rosé** Patrick Vauvy Loir Valley, France  
Grapes: 40% Gamay, 15% Cabernet Franc, 45% Others 2018 13% **V** £33.00

A pale, salmon-coloured rosé. On the nose, this wine is floral but there are hints of spice which follow through on the palate. Volume and freshness are combined in equal measure and the satisfying finish will leave you wanting more. The Domaine has been the hands of the Vauvy family for generations. Located above the banks of the Cher River, the soil is predominantly sand-based, giving the wines a fruit-driven, immediately appealing style. 'Other' grapes used include the spicy, local Pineau d'Aunis.



## RED WINE **Elegant and Smooth**

Wines within this section display fresh fruit aromas and a softness that makes them great to drink both on their own or with lighter styles of food. Whilst lovers of “big” reds may sometimes leave these styles overlooked, they do deserve a place on every wine list. The juicy fruit flavours and intrinsic, refreshing acidity of these reds allow them to be a suitable match for many varieties of food including poultry, pastas and creamy cheese.

### **320 Terras do Sado** Sivipia Setúbal, Lisbon, Portugal

Grapes include: Aragonêz, Syrah and Alfrocheiro 2017 14% **£27.00**

Regional red wine made with grapes from the sandy terroir of the Setúbal peninsula. Fresh, soft and balanced in the mouth with a nose of red fruit flavours, such as strawberry. A clean palate of rounded tannins with a smooth acidity, supported by notes of spice and cherry. Highly drinkable.

### **326 Mencia Joven** Ribas del Cúa Bierzo, Spain

Grapes: 100% Mencia 2018 13.5% **£29.00**

The Mencia grape variety is closely related to Cabernet Franc and Ribas del Cúa's delightful wine is a great example of the similarities. Intensely aromatic on the nose with both red and black fruits and hints of lavender in the background. A lovely rounded, youthful palate with a creamy long finish this is joy to drink. Great with lamb.

### **360 Sangiovese** Caparzo Tuscany, Italy

Grapes: 100% Sangiovese 2019 13.5% **£31.00**

A single owner, a single wine maker. Three cellars in three principal Tuscan wine making areas. This wine is a terrific synergy between Elizabetta Gnudi Angelini's properties: Caparzo, Borgo Scopeto and Doga delle Clavule: each estate represented by a rose in the family shield. An intense, fruity and spicy bouquet with ripe blackberry, wild strawberry and vanilla in the finish. The palate is persistent and soft.

### **304 Blaufränkisch** Goldenits Burgenland, Austria

Grapes: 100% Blaufränkisch 2015 13% **V** **£31.00**

Burgenland is close to Lake Neusiedl, which straddles the Austrian-Hungarian border. The soils here are of black earth and stone on a clay base. Ageing takes place for a few months in a mixture of wooden barrels. It shows cherry fruit, with a light spice element. Medium palate with a smooth finish.

### **313 Pinot Noir** Weingut Winter Rheinhessen, Germany

Grapes: 100% Pinot Noir 2016 12.5% **V** **£32.00**

The grapes are grown around Dittelsheim on limey soil, then picked by hand, fermented for 21 days and aged for 14 months in oak. Elegant juiciness and finesse characterise this Pinot Noir. Its balanced acidity, combining with delicate tannins, help with the enjoyed length and drinkability of this wine.

### **370 Early Release Pinot Noir** Sixteen Ridges Herefordshire, U.K.

Grapes: 100% Pinot Noir 2019 12% **V** **£32.00**

An Early Release Pinot Noir from the Sixteen Ridges Vineyard in Herefordshire. This extra light-bodied red wine has bags of fresh raspberry, cherry and violet. Crafted to be drunk and enjoyed, right now!

### **307 Fleurie** Manoir du Carra Beaujolais, France

Grapes: 100% Gamay (noir à jus blanc) 2018 13% **£38.00**

Domaine Manoir du Carra is located in the small town of Denice, south of Burgundy and in the heart of the Beaujolais area. The property dates back to 1850 and has been bequeathed from father to son for five generations. It is now owned by Jean-Noël Sambardier and his wife Intense red colour. Subtle floral aromas: violet, peony and a hint of cinnamon spice. Full bodied with a raspberry like midpalate, Manoir du Carra is beautifully structured with a velvety mouth coating finish. Fleurie at it's very best.



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**319 Gamay**

Grapes: 100% Gamay

Aromas of raspberry and blueberry with herbal savory notes. On the palate, it is a refreshing combination of the crunchy, refreshing acidity of bright fruit flavours with undertones of savoury complexity. Wines are made as naturally as possible. Both vineyards and winery are organically certified in New Zealand. *No Added Sulphites.*

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**308 Santenay 'Clos des Hâtes'**

Grapes: 100% Carménère		2017 13.5% <b>VtO</b>	£32.00

A medley of aromas; from blackberry and dark chocolate to more savoury, meaty notes. The palate displays ripe dark fruits but also coffee and liquorice. The ripe present tannins offer a solid structure and the layers of complexity keep your attention.

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<b>301 Shiraz</b>	'Killibinbin'	Langhorne Creek, South Australia	
Grapes: 100% Shiraz		2013 14.5%	£33.00

Bright crimson in colour, this wine has lovely raspberry coulis and red fruit medley with vanilla. Medium bodied on the palate, yet mouth-filling, approachable and generous. Lightly oaked with French oak.

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<b>303 Colton's 'G.S.M.'</b>	Richard Hamilton	McLaren Vale, S. Australia	
Grapes: 53% Grenache, 30% Shiraz and 17% Mourvèdre		2016 14.5%	£34.00

This family owned estate can trace its origins back to 1837. The Colton homestead overlooks the gently sloping vineyard on which the varieties sourced for this wine are grown. Medium to full red with attractive crimson. Subtle use of oak allows the fruit to shine through to reveal attractive hints of boiled fruit cake with cinnamon and cloves. Put it in big glass and savour the fragrance. A beautifully round palate with silky tannins and soft acidity, this wine has lovely persistence and length.





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**315 Barbera d'Asti** Montalbera 'Solo Acciaio' Piedmont, Italy

Representative of Piedmont traditions. Without wood influence, extreme elegance and fresh suppleness combine with a fruity punch, obtained by harvesting slightly over-ripe. In the commune of Saillans, seven generations of wine-growers have been tending to the vines of this estate, currently ran by Thierry Jean-Pascal, with maxims of tradition and technical control. 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**316 Cannonau** Mora & Memo Sardinia, Italy  
Grapes: 100% Cannonau 2017 14.5% **V** £39.00

Impenetrable ruby red with violet reflections. Bouquet of red berries, spices and coffee. Smooth and elegant tannins in a great structure and complexity. Aged in French oak for three months.

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**390 Le Colombier** Massaya Beqaa Valley, Lebanon  
35% Cinsault, 35% Grenache Noir, 15% Syrah, 15% Tempranillo 2018 14.5% £39.00

Grown 900 to 1,200 metres above sea level and matured for a year in Faqra (Mount Lebanon) cellars. Pepper and spice distinguish this refreshing, fruity wine. A touch of chocolate harmonises the ripe nose of blackberry, morello cherry and violet. Rewarding, quality wine with fine tannins and excellent length.

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**332 'The Velvet Devil' Merlot** Charles Smith Wines Washington State, U.S. of A.  
Grapes: 89% Merlot 10% Cabernet Sauvignon 1% Malbec 2016 13.5% £41.00

As advertised, this bold, smooth Merlot offers pure velvet, deep and delicious black fruit, cedar, tobacco and cassis. This fresh and appealing blend conveys concentrated richness yet purity and focus. Medium-bodied and dry with a fresh, vivid flavour and rich colour. Crafted in Washington state in growing regions that add unique wine characteristics.

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**317 Produttori del Barbaresco** Albeisa Nebbiolo Langhe, Italy  
Grapes: 100% Nebbiolo 2017 14% £50.00

Estate grown, with a natural light red appearance. Rich, spicy red fruit with notes of tobacco, roses and cherry, carried by a consuming palate of intense natural tannins, delivering true Nebbiolo character.

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**329 Tempranillo Graciano** 'Ángeles de Amaren' Rioja Alavesa, Spain  
Grapes: 85% Tempranillo and 15% Graciano 2013 14.5% **Vt** £53.00

Cherry red with intense aromas of pronounced fruit over a delicate background of oak. Lactic nuances and spicy touches. Tasty and expressive with smooth, fresh tannins and balanced acidity. Long finish with reminiscences of red and black fruit. Fresh, lively and persistent.



## RED WINE **Powerful and Weighty**

These full-bodied reds are mouth-coating; a result of 'weightier' grape varieties or having spent some time in oak barrels. The maturation enhances both flavour and structure, providing added depth and robust character. Usually containing moderate to very high levels of tannin, these wines are rich and often laden with luscious fruit. Furthermore, they make more than suitable partners to stronger foods. Try with hard cheese, steak, game, blue cheese and dark chocolate.

**314 Baglio Gibellina** U.Passimiento Sicily, Italy  
Grapes: 70% Nero d'Avola and 30% Frappato 2018 13.5% **V** £30.00

Bright and intense red fruit on the nose, displaying lots of red berries. The palate is warm and full-bodied with harmonious acidity and smooth and elegant tannins.

**331 Old Vine Zinfandel** Ironstone Vineyards Lodi, California, U. S. of A.  
Grapes: 90% Zinfandel, 5% Petite Syrah and 5% Shiraz 2016 14.5% £34.00

From vineyards over 45 years old, comes exceptional varietal character. Flavours of blackberry, ripe plum and fresh, red raspberry mingle with subtle pepper spice. A smooth, silky finish with unprecedented depth. Ironstone Vineyards is part of California's sustainable wine growing programme.

**302 Cabernet Sauvignon** Leconfield 'Kudos' Coonawarra, S. Australia  
Grapes: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon 2016 14.5% £34.00

Rich Terra Rosa soil over limestone provides the ideal environment for Cabernet Sauvignon. Ripe cassis and blackberry fruit nose integrated with red cedar, nutmeg and cinnamon through maturation in predominantly French oak. The palate is beautifully textured with succulent persistence, fine tannins and balanced acidity. The rich flavour reflects the early-ripening vintage yet retains elegance expected.

**328 Cuvée de Caïr** Dominio de Caïr Ribera del Duero, Spain  
Grapes: 85% Tempranillo and 15% Merlot 2016 14.5% **Vt** £40.00

Garnet in colour. Complex and inviting aromas of ripe berry fruit, raisins and caramel. Dairy nuances over a slightly smoky background with hints of jam and spice. Easy-drinking style but full bodied, fleshy and silky-smooth with sweet, polished tannins.

**324 'One Man Band'** Iona Elgin, South Africa  
44% Syrah, 26% Cabernet Sauvignon, 23% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot, 2% Mourvèdre 2012 14% **Vt** £48.00

The wine shows cassis fruit with exotic spice and notes of red fruit. It is layered with fragrant ripe blackberry and cherry, with underlying spice, cedar and white pepper characteristics. The palate is seamless, with elegant fine-grained tannins.

**325 Cabernet Franc** Guerila Selection Vipava Valley, Slovenia  
Grapes: 100% Cabernet Franc 2017 13.5% **VO** £52.00

Displaying typical varietal characteristics of Cabernet Franc. Very complex aroma and flavour of dry plums, forest undergrowth, wild leather, tobacco and pepper. A rich, full body with an exceptionally long aftertaste and pleasing freshness. The biodynamically produced grapes are hand-picked and crushed for a four-week maceration. After natural fermentation and ageing for eighteen months in Slovenian oak, the wine is bottled according to Maria Thun moon calendar with minimum sulphur.



**309 Châteauneuf-du-Pape** Mas de Boislauzon Rhône Valley, France

There are Chateauneuf du Pape's and then there is Mas de Boislauzon. This is an incredible wine made from 60-year-old vine parcels, this wonderful, layered, Châteauneuf is loaded with blackberry, black cherry and hints of earth and violets. The palate is rich, multidimensional and silky. Always very limited and the average rating of the Mas de Boislauzon has been averaging over 93/100 for the last 7 years! A rare treat.

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**318 Amarone della Valpolicella** Latium Morini 'Campo Leon' Veneto, Italy

70% Corvina, 20% Rondinella and 10% Croatina/Oseleta 2013 16% **V** £81.00

Consistent ruby colour. Very intense and ample with nuances of ripe red fruits, kirsch and spicy notes, such as vanilla, nutmeg, black pepper and cocoa. The mouth is very warm, soft and fresh, with delicate oak and tannins. A wine with a rich body.

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**333 'Crossbarn'** Paul Hobbs Napa Valley, California U.S.A.

Grape variety: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon 2015 15% £84.00

Dark ruby in colour, with enticing aromas of dark cherries, ripe blueberries, anise and fresh lavender. A tantalising palate offers a medley of boysenberry, currants, violets, clove and cocoa. Tannins are sweet and smooth. Balanced acidity brightens a lengthy finish.

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**311 Saint-Julien 'Clos du Marquis'** Château Léoville Las Cases Bordeaux, France

70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot, 8% Cabernet Franc, 2% Petit Verdot 2000 13% £140.00

One quarter had been aged in new oak. Quite mineral on the nose, together with dark fruit: a good intensity of blackcurrant and pomegranate with raspberry and vanilla. A medium-bodied yet generous palate with grainy tannins, graphite and a touch of tar interlaced with the dark fruit. Superbly harmonious and with a freshness that brings it's flavours alive. Seamless in texture with a togetherness and class that greatly impresses.

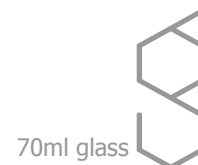
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**312 Grand Cru Pauillac** Château Haut Batailley Bordeaux, France

70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 3% Cabernet Franc, 2% Petit Verdot 1996 13% £150.00

The name is derived from the *battle* that took place, where the château and vineyards are today, during the hundred years war around 1453. The first vines were planted on these historical and blood-soaked grounds in the 16<sup>th</sup> century. Château Batailley was knighted 'Grand Cru Classé' following Napoleon III's 1855 creation of the classifications of the Médoc. A classic Pauillac with blackcurrant flavours and a very good structure.

**502 Pink Muscat** Stella Bella Margaret River, Western Australia  
Grape variety: 100% Muscat Blanc à Petits Grains 2017 7.2% £6.75 £33

The finest variety of Muscat grape is used to create Stella Bella Pink Muscat, inspired by the Italian Moscato d'Asti wine from the piedmont region in Italy's north, which is made from this very same grape. A blushing pink bouquet of exotic fragrances: rose petal, musk and Turkish delight. Fresh flavours of gooseberries and sautéed summer berries. Not too sweet with a light acidity. Very, very slightly 'frizzante'.

**503 Chenin Blanc** Kika Late Harvest Stellenbosch, South Africa  
Grapes: 100% Chenin Blanc 2016 12% £9.25 £47

Brilliant gold in colour, with lime-green highlights. The nose is accented by intense aromas of apricot, quince, grilled pineapple and ginger spice. The wine enters the palate fully and richly, with intense flavours of poached pears, quince, honey glazed almonds and ginger bread. There is a tannic grip to the mid-palate, leading to a clean, crisp finish. The wine embodies the perfect balance between acidity and sweetness.

**504 'MÁD'** St. Tamas Tokaji, Hungary  
50% Furmint, 30% Muscat Blanc á Petit Grains, 20% Hárslevelű 2016 11% **V** £9.00 £45

This unique dessert wine is sweet, with the wonderful aromatic nuance of the area. Pure fruit flavours of mango, grape and pineapple are both on the note and palate. A rich and sweet texture, yet balanced and not cloying. Lightened by a distinct acidity and leaving a smooth, moreish and lengthy finish. Goes surprisingly well with blue cheese.

Dark purple, this wine shows an incredible fruity intensity: It is a young and vigorous red Port with good concentration of colour. Its appetising aromas are both fruity and tasty. Very well balanced and full in the mouth. Made from traditional grape varieties and aged for three years in large barrels.

**603 Quinta do Portal 'Six Barrels' Tawny Reserve** Douro, Portugal  
Grapes: Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca and Tinta Roriz N.V. 20% **Vt** £6.00 £55

Called 'Tawny' for its colour due to the ageing in oak. The nose reveals aromas of dried fruits and raisins. The well-balanced palate and the smoothness give us a good idea of the slow ageing process. This is a blend of tawny Ports aged for 7 years in our cellars after a careful selection of the best 6 barrels. The brand of this Portal Port is also a tribute to Quinta do Portal's founder to each one of his 6 grandchildren. Enjoy slightly chilled with egg-based desserts, fruit pies and soft cheeses.

**604 Quinta do Portal Late Bottled Vintage** Douro, Portugal  
35% Touriga Nacional, 35% Tinta Roriz, 30% Touriga Franca 2013 20% **Vt** £7.00 £63

Concentrated ruby colour, shows well balanced fruit with some notes of spice and cocoa. Big on the palate with rounded tannins, a complex bouquet and a harmonious and long finish. A young and robust LBV with spicy notes. Aged for four years in old barrels.

**606 Warre's Quinta da Cavadinha** Douro, Portugal  
Grapes: Traditional Varieties 1996 20% £120

Smooth, deeply coloured and with flavours of mulberry, raisin and prunes, this delicious single-quinta vintage port is from only one of Warre's vineyards: Quinta da Cavadinha in the Douro Superior. It has matured gracefully over the years and is now ready for drinking!
