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## White

- 47 Chablis 1er Cru, Domaine Damppt France** £36.50  
*Apple, pear, wet wool and mineral. Weighty but focused with lots of flesh and fine minerality. Classic and balanced.*
- 48 Pouilly Fume de Ladocquette France** £46.00  
*It has exceptional elegance and depth with lovely ripe pear flavours overlaying a firm gooseberry structure.*
- 49 Chassagne Montrachet, Domaine Guy Amiot France** £62.75  
*Ripe mineral pear fruit aromas. Big and rich with complexity from the oak.*

## Rose

- 50 Sancerre Rose, Sylvain Bailly France** £34.25  
*Pleasant bouquet of strawberries and raspberries. Fresh and lively.*

## Red

- 51 Chataeu Tour de By, Bordeaux France** £43.95  
*On the nose black fruit flavours and some quite molten wood notes. Very ripe and firm tannins.*
- 52 Chat Puy Razac Saint Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux France** £42.50  
*A rich wine deep ruby colour, nose dominated by stewed red fruits, good body.*
- 53 Beaune 1er Cru, Domaine Marchand Gramont France** £54.00  
*An attractive, fruity wine, it is already in balance. The fruit comes out strongly with its red berry and black cherry flavours with just a herbal, fresher hint.*
- 54 Gevrey Chambertin, Louis Latour France** £77.00  
*Astounding animal notes combined with aromas of wild black berries make this a grand wine.*
- 55 Crozes-Hermtiage, E.Guigal France** £40.00  
*Dark and deep in colour, aromas of red fruits, cherry, strawberry, vanilla with delicate oak aromas.*

## CHAMPAGNE

- 1 Champagne Philippe Fourrier France** £39.00  
*Beautifully crafted Pinot Noir and Chardonnay blend from a highly respected 8th generation family.*
- 2 Champagne Veuve Cliquot, Yellow Label France** £72.00  
*A blend of up to 50 different crus mainly Grand and Premier go into the blending of Brut Yellow Label. The initial notes of white fruits are followed by toasted brioche and vanilla all held together by a streak of minerality and racy acidity.*
- 3 Blanc de Blancs, Champagne Henriot France** £79.50  
*This cuvée offers exceptional freshness with astonishing complexity and length. It's floral and fruity with pastry and spicy notes, with aromas of lightly toasted brioche and acacia honey.*

*100% Pinot Noir, delicious strawberry and fresh raspberry inflected full bodied pink Champagne.*
- 5 Laurent Perrier Cuvee Rosé France** £79.00  
*Subtle forthright and very fresh on the nose Cuvée Rosé Laurent-Perrier is a lively well-rounded wine which combines structure and freshness with an abundance of red berry fruits.*

## SPARKLING WINE

- 6 Prosecco, Undici Italy** £5.95 125ml Bottle £28.00  
*100% Glera grapes make up this full-bodied lively and refreshing Prosecco. With subtle hints of pear skin and surprising length.*

- 7 Grenache/Syrah Rose, Le Grand Noir France** £26.00  
*Intense aromas of raspberry, strawberry and redcurrant with a hint of pepper. Rich palette with refreshing bright, red fruit and peppery character.*
- 8 Pinot Grigio Rose, Flavorelli Italy** £4.95 175ml £6.95 250ml £19.00  
*A crisp refreshing style of rosé wine. Light and soft on the palate easy drinking and bursting with summer berry flavours.*

### On the sweeter side


- 9 White Zinfandel, Frocks and Thrills USA** £4.65 175ml £6.45 250ml £18.00  
*Bright salmon-pink colour and a fresh nose of raspberry and strawberries. Juicy yet elegant, soft and creamy, medium to sweet in style.*

## Light, fresh and delicious

- 10 Viura, Pleno, Navarra Spain** £4.65 £6.45 £18.00  
*Fresh dry white with tropical fruit on the nose and a smooth well-balanced body. Well made wine from a state-of-the-art bodega.*
- 11 Riesling, Papparuda Romania**  £4.75 £6.50 £18.50  
*With lime and white pepper on the nose this is a light elegant dry wine full of citrus fruit and backed up by a zingy acidity. Eminently quaffable with well-defined fruit and great balance.*
- 12 Sauvignon Blanc, Aves del Sur Chile** £5.00 £6.75 £19.50  
*Crisp and refreshing Sauvignon Blanc with aromas of freshly cut grass tropical fruit and herbaceous flowers. On the palate flavours of grapefruit and white peach with a lively finish.*
- 13 Vinho Verde, Raza Portugal** £30.00  
*At 11.5% alcohol, Raza is a blend of Arinto, Azal and Trajadura. With a fizzy crispness and easy, fruity finish, it is in a familiar style, but clean and invigorating.*
- 14 Sauvignon Blanc, La Villaudiere, Reverdy France** £30.50  
*Jean-Marie Reverdy works wonders with Sauvignon Blanc in the Loire Valley, and this is their 'baby Sancerre.' Classic notes of fresh grass, blackcurrant bud and gooseberry make this a classic and delicious wine.*
- 15 Dart Valley Reserve, Sharpham Estate England** £38.00  
*This off-dry and ever popular wine has a light fresh character. Lovely fruit aromas with supple delicate flavours and a toasty oak finish result in a wine ideal for drinking alone or with food.*

## Aromatic, fruit filled and luscious

- 16 Pinot Grigio, Orietto Moldova** £5.25 £7.25 £20.50  
*Delicious and perfectly balanced this crisp dry Pinot Grigio is packed with citrus fruit and subtle floral aromas. More complex than the usual Italian style!*
- 17 Piesporter Michelsberg, Franz Reh and Sohn Germany** £6.00 £8.00 £23.00  
*From the super-efficient co-operative at Bernkastel this is a deliciously fruity low-alcohol wine that has a fresh fruit character and an attractive off-dry sweetness. Ideal as an aperitif or with spicy food.*
- 18 Sauvignon Blanc, Osprey's Landing New Zealand** £7.00 £9.50 £27.95  
*The wine has an enticing palate with flavours of juicy nectarine and pineapple with that classic Marlborough zing!*
- 19 Gewurztraminer, Santa Digna Chile** £28.00  
*Golden yellow in colour this Gewurztraminer from the Central Valley has a classic honey-and-Rose bouquet. A fine full-bodied wine with tropical fruit and perfumed characters all balanced by a bite of refreshing acidity.*

## Aromatic, fruit filled and luscious continued...

**20 Chardonnay, Sunnycliff Australia** £27.00

*Green apple and pear aromas with upfront tropical fruit dominate the palate of this refreshing Australian Chardonnay. The mouthfeel is crisp and fresh with a lingering finish.*

**21 Pinot Gris, Dopff and Irion France** £38.00

*Boasting a subtle and elegant nose with smoky yellow fruit aromas this Pinot gris offers well-balanced pear plum and quince on the palate as well as good weight and plenty of aromatic persistence.*

## Rich and weighty

**22 Chardonnay, Le Petit Noir France** £5.75 £7.75 £22.00

*Yellow green colour intense aromas of lime mango yellow fruit buttery. Rich palette with yellow fruit lime flavours with fresh balance.*

**23 Viognier Minervois, Le Grand Noir France** £6.50 £8.85 £26.00

*A little Chardonnay is added to the blend here giving the wine extra freshness and to compliment its delightful mango and apricot flavours. Unoaked it's a truly classy example of Viognier.*

**24 Chenin Blanc/Semillon, Footprint South Africa** £27.00

*Juicy, tropical fruit flavours of Chenin Blanc complements the pear and citrus flavours of Semillon.*

**25 Macon-Villages, Domaine de la Denante France** £33.00

*Brilliant value from a brilliant, talented young wine maker. Clean, fresh and racy Chardonnay with real elegance.*

**26 Petit Chablis, Louis Moreau France** £35.00

*Freshness is key here delivering far from 'petit' flavour and steely minerality. Louis Moreau has been making excellent stylish food friendly and polished Chablis since 1814 winning major awards with his hallmark flinty fresh balanced wines which only the Chardonnay vineyards of Northern Burgundy can deliver every year.*

### Juicy and unfussy

**27 Tempranillo, Pleno Spain** £4.65 £6.45 £18.00

*Soft lively and well-made this Tempranillo has bags of attractive red berry fruit on the nose which carries through to a fresh smooth palate dominated by blackcurrant and spice notes.*

**28 Pinot Noir, Paparuda Romania**  £4.85 £6.50 £18.50

*With fresh aromas of strawberry raspberry and caramel on the nose this extremely drinkable light-bodied Pinot has bags of succulent red berry fruit on the palate all wrapped up with lashings of toasted oak on the finish.*

**29 Beaujolais, Jean-Etienne Chermette France** £28.50

*Fresh and juicy Gamay from exciting young winemaker Jean-Etienne Chermette. One of the most food friendly wines you'll find!*

**30 Valpolicella Superior, Zenato Italy** £42.00

*Intense dark fruit aromas, complex palate and a long yet refreshing finish.*

### Spicy and well rounded

**31 Merlot, Le Petit Noir France** £5.25 £6.75 £19.50

*Deep red colour with purple fringe intense aromas of red berry fruit. Crisp blackcurrant flavours married with the flavours of ripe plums form the length of this wine. Balanced tannin finish. Easy drinking red produced for early enjoyment.*

**32 Shiraz, Sea Mountain South Africa** £6.00 £8.25 £23.00

*This wine has an explosive aroma of espresso, fruitcake and sweet oak spice. The palate is rich and soft, with ripe flavours of black cherries and a long complex aftertaste.*

**33 Crianza, Rioja Santiago Spain** £6.50 £8.85 £26.00

*Aged for at least one year in American oak barrels followed by six months in bottle this Tempranillo-Garnacha blend is everything you'd expect from a top-quality Rioja Crianza and more. Soft and smoky with warm vanilla and juicy red berry flavours it is delicious enjoyed with roast lamb or tapas dishes.*

**34 Cotes du Rhone, Domaine Verquire France** £30.00

*This delightful medium-bodied Grenache-Syrah blend is elegant and generous on the nose with red berry fruit and roasted plums on the palate. Organically grown in the Southern Rhone village of Sablet this is the perfect match for red meat and game.*

**35 Carmenere, Caliterra Chile** £23.75

*Blackberry and raspberry notes followed by hints of cinnamon, anise and liquorice. The palate is soft with round, ripe and smooth tannins.*

**36 Crozes-Hermitage, Reverdy France** £40.00

*After spending 12 months in oak, this Crozes Hermitage has still plenty of red fruit and blackcurrant aromas on the nose. The palate is intense with ripe red fruit flavours and smooth tannins.*

<i>Complex nutty aromas, combined with hints of honey and figs. On the palate rich, mature fruit flavours; beautifully mellowed; with a luscious, long finish.</i>
