### *Citrusy & Fruity*

**Staibano Positano Gin** : It features the wonderful combo of rosemary and Amalfi lemons among its botanical, alongside a secret recipe of... Well, secret botanicals.

**Ginato:** blended Tuscan juniper, Sicilian citrus and Italian Pinot Grigio grapes! Lots of white fruit notes to be enjoyed thanks to the addition of the grapes – perhaps a gin for wine.

**Family of Hounds 9 Botanicals London Dry Gin:** Botanicals include juniper, lemon and orange peel, pink grapefruit, lavender and thyme, all of which are sourced from Italy. A fabulously juniper forward gin which would make an outstanding Martini.

**Villa Ascenti Rose'**: distinctive fruity flavour with a smooth, creamy, and delicious complex fresh palate. Enhanced through copper distillation, the ripe plump peaches give a sweet fruity note.

**Beefeater Rose'**: real gin with juniper and citrus but also fresh, natural strawberries and not too much sweetness. Strawberry flavour added after distillation.

**Tonic recommendation:** Fever tree lemonade

**Portofino Dry Gin:** Distilled with a medley of 21 Mediterranean botanicals, including lavender, rosemary, sage, and lemon, alongside classic juniper, this Italian gin combines old and new production methods. Made using a retired grappa still, as well as cutting edge vacuum distillation, superb for G&T's.

**Tonic recommendation:** Fever tree Mediterranean tonic water

**Villa Ascenti:** made using a secret combination of locally sourced botanicals, including Tuscan juniper berries, fresh mint, thyme and Moscato grape.

**Tonic recommendation:** Fever tree Sicilian lemon tonic water

**Tosolini:** made with a spirit based on grapes, which adds a faint sweetness to this classic style herbal gin. The vegetables used include Friulian juniper berries, Moscato grapes, coriander seeds and vanilla beans, made with spring water from the Italian Alps

**Tonic recommendation:** Fever tree Sicilian lemon tonic water

**Hendricks:** It features the likes of juniper, cubeb berries, elderflower, chamomile, angelica, lemon peel, orange peel, coriander, yarrow and orris, alongside an infusion of cucumber and rose petal.

**Ginepraio London Dry Gin:** This fragrant Tuscan gin is named after the Italian saying, 'cacciarsi in un ginepraio', which means to get stuck in a mess. seven local botanicals, including juniper, dogrose and helichrysum (a wild plant found on the Tyrrhenian side of Italy and in Sardinia).

**Tonic recommendation:** Fever tree elderflower tonic water

**Seven Hills VII Italian Gin:** a combination of seven locally sourced botanicals - juniper, celery, rose hip, artichoke, blood orange, chamomile and pomegranate. A proudly Italian gin which was absolutely made for Negroni cocktails, so get mixing!

**Wolfrest Gin Italiano:** This gin is made in Piedmont, exclusively with botanicals grown in Italy, including juniper berries from Umbria, sweet orange from Liguria, elder flower from Piedmont, and bay leaf, thyme, wild rosemary, and hazelnut from Langhe. With a sweet nuttiness, and a complex, herbal bouquet, Wolfrest Gin conjures up images of warm, summer forests, and delicious G&T's.

<i>Organic and natural wines are made with grapes that are grown without the use of synthetic pesticides, herbicides, or fertilizers. This means that they are healthier for you and the environment. They also tend to be lower in sulphites, which can cause headaches and other allergic reactions in some people. Organic and natural wines are often made with older vines, which produce richer and more complex flavours. They are also usually made in small batches, which allows the winemaker to pay more attention to detail.</i>
