SOFT & SMOOTH

MERLOT VIÑA CARRASCO, CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE £25

Luis Felipe Edwards is one of Chile's leading family-owned wineries and this Merlot offers good depth of fruit, with a soft & plummy texture and hints of vanilla. A smooth, easy-drinking example of Chilean Merlot.

CARMENERE RESERVA, CLARO, COLCHAGUA VALLEY, CHILE £27

Carmenere has become Chile's flagship red grape with its smooth texture, soft fruit and a hint of spice complemented by well-balanced tannins. The Claro Reserva is aged in a combination of French and American oak which adds depth and complexity to this Carmenere.

BEAUJOLAIS VILLAGES, DOMAINE du SABOT, 2018 BEAUJOLAIS £32

Beaujolais is the iconic light-bodied red and this Maison Jean Loron Beaujolais Villages is well balanced with juicy strawberry, raspberry and cherry fruit flavours. A bright and elegant Gamay with a fresh finish.

RULLY ROUGE, PINOT NOIR, MAISON CHANZY, 2019 BURGUNDY £40

An elegant Burgundy from the Cote Chalonnaise. This Pinot Noir is superbly smooth and stuffed full of bright red fruit flavours - think cherries and redcurrants - with a fine firm tannic structure and balancing acidity that makes it a great foil for all manner of food.

POWERFUL & RICH

MALBEC, CAMINO ACERO, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA £28

Mendoza, Argentina's Malbec-heartland, is the place to look for the style of lush, fruity Malbec which put Argentina on the map. This is a big and bold Malbec that leads with intense fruit. The oak gives a vanilla character and there is a serious backbone to this wine with velvety soft tannins.

ROSSO PUGLIA APPASSIMENTO, APERICENA, PUGLIA, ITALY £29

Rich, velvety and bold, this stunning example of the appassimento method, where the Primitivo and Negroamoro grapes are dried off-vine before fermentation, delivers concentrated flavours of red fruit. This Rosso Puglia is luscious and full-bodied.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, GRAN RESERVA, TERRA VEGA, COLCHAGUA, CHILE £29

An award winning, powerful yet elegant Cabernet Sauvignon. A bold juicy red where the tannins are softened by 5 years in oak casks making it a perfect partner for beef & game.

PINOTAGE, KANONKOP KADETTE, STELLENBOSCH, 2018 SOUTH AFRICA £35

Pinotage is South Africa's signature variety. Try it done by Kanonkop, who produce a complex wine, with aromas of red fruits, hints of mocha, elegant tannins and a long finish. You'll have a seriously hard time finding a better expression of Pinotage beyond the Kadette.

RUPERT & ROTHSCHILD CLASSIQUE, STELLENBOSCH, SOUTH AFRICA £39

A superb South African take on the classic Bordeaux Blend and the brainchild of 2 legendary winemaking dynasties. The expert blending of Merlot with Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc results in a wine brimming with cranberry, black cherry, hazelnut and chocolate. A true classic!

CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, DOMAINE DURIEU, RHÔNE £50

A heady bouquet of raspberry, redcurrant and strawberry that's backed by regal aromas of sweet spice and chocolate. A garnet-red wine with a silky-smooth palate and wonderful complexity, delivered with consistent quality - the hallmarks that have always made Chateaufneuf-du-Pape such a stellar wine.

COMPLEX & INTRIGUING

RIOJA RESERVA, CONDE DE CASTILE, TEMPRANILLO, RIOJA, SPAIN £30

Full of black fruit with hints of cocoa, clove and cinnamon. Big flavours and grippy tannins, tempered by the Reserva minimum of 3 years lush oak ageing, ensure this Rioja pairs perfectly with rich game and duck dishes.

SAINT-EMILION, ESPRIT DE LUSSAC, BORDEAUX £35

Classic Bordeaux Claret with Merlot leading the profile to ensure a super smooth, silky body with juicy black fruit on the nose and cranberry nuances, tied together with a smoky sandalwood character. The Lussac is a great value entry into what justifiably makes the Right



VALPOLICELLA RIPASSO, CLASSICO SUPERIORE, LA CASSETTA, VENETO, ITALY £39

La Casetta is a Valpolicella Ripasso with a difference. Most Ripasso techniques add the leftover skins from Amarone production to standard Valpolicella. But with La Casetta, they go a step further. They add the skins from Recioto, which adds a whole new level of depth and intensity, pushing it into another dimension of flavour. Bright red cherry. Plum. Dried fruit. It's fantastically full with a really plush texture. Fine and rounded, a velvety smooth palate bursting with complex flavours.

THE CHOCOLATE BLOCK, BOEKENHOUTSKLOOF, WESTERN CAPE, SOUTH AFRICA £49

The Chocolate Block is a cult favourite that blends Syrah with Grenache, Cinsault & Cabernet Sauvignon with a touch of Viognier. An earthy, rustic nose gives up aromas of leather and spices over a backdrop of blackcurrant and ripe raspberry fruit and plush chocolate notes. Harmonious and rich on the palate, this is an iconic and a multi award-winning classic of South African winemaking.

SEGLA, MARGAUX, BORDEAUX £60

A stellar wine, this Left Bank Cabernet Sauvignon led classic blend is rich and indulgent with bright fruit flavours of cherry and blackcurrant enhanced by notes of cedar and vanilla. A superb example of iconic Medoc quality.

WHITE

LIGHT & CRISP

OMBRELLINO PINOT GRIGIO CATARRATTO, ITALY £25

A light and refreshing Pinot Grigio with subtle hints of stone fruit, joined by flavours of lemon, lime and a honeyed edge. Fresh and vibrant with all the hallmarks that make Pinot Grigio Italy's deliciously drinkable light-bodied and crisp white.

PICPOUL DE PINET, ORMARINE SEA PEARL, LANGUEDOC £29

A youthful white wine from the South of France full of lively lemon fruit and lime zest flavours. This Picpoul has a bright and vibrant character with a refreshing lick of acidity.

ALBARINO, EL CANTE DEL MAR, RIAS BAIXAS, SPAIN £35

Delightfully light, fresh and elegant, Albarino is Galicia in a glass. Citrus flavours are beautifully balanced by apricot and peach which add body, making Albarino the perfect partner for all manner of seafood.

POWERFUL & FRUITY

VERDEJO DOMINIO DE LA FUENTE ORGANIC, RUEDA, CASTILLA y LEON, SPAIN £26

Verdejo is bang on-trend, gaining increasing recognition as a wine with an irresistible combination of powerful fruit and crisp acidity. Bright, pale straw yellow, with intense, fresh notes of grass, lime, fennel and white pepper that give this Verdejo a wee lift. A real wow alternative for traditional Sauvignon Blanc enthusiasts.

VINHO VERDE, LUA NOVA,, DOURO, PORTUGAL £27

Vinho Verde is Portugal's flagship white. Fresh floral notes, a hint of grapefruit and a comparatively low abv of 10% make this is a seriously thirst-quenching, drinkable wine.

KOKAKO SAUVIGNON BLANC, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND £31

New Zealand's Marlborough region produces outstanding Sauvignon Blanc, which has become the go-to white wine across the UK. Kokako is an elegant Sauvignon Blanc with aromas of gooseberries and tropical fruit leading to a crisp and refreshing finish. Clearly demonstrates why Marlborough is leading the way with some of the New World's finest Sauvignon Blancs.

POUILLY-FUMÉ PIERRE BREVIN, LOIRE VALLEY £42

Pouilly-Fumé is one of the Loire Valley's most revered whites, rivalled only by Sancerre when it comes to Sauvignon Blanc. An inviting pale lemon-gold, with subtle aromas of grass, fresh fennel and the iconic wisp of gun smoke characteristic of Pouilly-Fumé, set against a backdrop of citrus. A ripe grapefruit palate with refreshing, zesty acidity.

SANCERRE, DUC ARMAND, LOIRE VALLEY £45

Another star of the Loire Valley, Sancerre is the spiritual home of Old World Sauvignon Blanc. The area on the left bank of the Loire River's rolling limestone hills and relatively cool climate delivers richly textured Sauvignon Blanc with invigorating acidity. Duc Armand is an elegant Sancerre, with a pale yellow colour, aromas of white flowers, green apple and refreshing citrus flavours. A superb, pure expression of Sauvignon Blanc.

ROUNDED & RICH

CHARDONNAY GRAN RESERVA, TERRA VEGA, LEYDA VALLEY, CHILE £28

This is an award-winning Chilean Chardonnay, rich and mouth-filling with notes of melon, vanilla and apple flavours brought together by soft toasted undertones. A stylish Chardonnay with the Gran Reserva barrel ageing imparting a light oak, toasty richness. A great example of how Chile is really delivering on the price/quality value ratio.

VIOGNIER, BARON de BAUSSAC, LANGUEDOC £29.5

This Viognier is smooth and rounded, perfectly expressing the signature repertoire of fantastic flavours of peach, apricot and hints of grapefruit. A generous bodied fleshy white, with a rich, creamy texture.

CHABLIS, DOMAINE PASSY LE CLOU, BURGUNDY £48

Chablis is the northernmost region of Burgundy and this cold continental climate makes for a zesty, mineral, laser-focused expression of Old World Chardonnay – some would even say its quintessential expression. Crisp and elegant with refined flavours of luscious apple and citrus fruit. This Chablis shows remarkable purity and a delightful balance between acidity and roundness.

POUILLY-FUISSÉ, DOMAINE TROUILLET, BURGUNDY £50

Pouilly-Fuissé neighbours Saint Véran and it's where you'll find some of Burgundy's richest, ripest Chardonnay. Domaine Trouillet is a small boutique estate in the Maconnais and the merits of this distinguished appellation shine in this complex, elegant expression of Chardonnay. It's full-flavoured with fresh notes of almond and citrus, followed by plush peach, brioche and honey, with a bold, buttery character perfectly balanced by fresh acidity.

ROSÉ

TWO BIRDS, ONE STONE ROSÉ, SOUTH OF FRANCE £25

This soft pink Cinsault is a fantastic example of an easy drinking Rosé full of summer fruit flavours, with a delicious hint of sweetness.

WHISPERING ANGEL ROSÉ, CHATEAU d'ESCLANS, COTES de PROVENCE £45

Whispering Angel must be the most famous Provence Rosé, completely redefining the category with the creation of this iconic pink. Made by Sacha Lichine, a master in the art of Rosé, who took over Château d'Esclans in 2006. He introduced ground-breaking winemaking techniques, which revolutionised Provence Rosé – with Whispering Angel as the figurehead. It has fresh notes of apple, pink grapefruit, peach and cream, and a long, smooth finish. A truly sensational Rosé adored by wine lovers across the world.

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

PROSECCO BEL CANTO , VENETO, ITALY £30

Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles, this Prosecco carries lots of fresh peach, pear and an elegant zest. A great example of why Italian bubbly is so popular in the UK.

GRAHAM BECK BRUT, WESTERN CAPE, SOUTH AFRICA £40

You'll be in good company when you uncork a bottle of this Brut. It's affectionately known as the 'President's Choice' because it was served at both Nelson Mandela's inauguration and Barack Obama's presidential win. It's made with the Méthode Cap Classique – a style identical to the traditional method used to make Champagne, using Chardonnay and Pinot Noir too. It means it's a real steal for fizz fans who love the taste of Champagne – but not the price. Fresh but creamy. Full of limey citrus flavours – it's got a lovely brioche richness from its second fermentation in the bottle. An inviting nose full of lightly yeasty aromas. The palate offers fresh, gentle lime fruit delivered with a fine mousse, giving the wine a creamy texture on the finish.

FIAMMETTA ROSÉ PROSECCO, VENETO, ITALY £30

This is a delicious Rosé fizz, displaying an elegant shell-pink colour with typical copper hues. Expect bright notes of strawberries and raspberries, with a refreshing mousse.

PAUL DROUET BRUT NV, CHAMPAGNE £55

This traditional blend of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier displays finesse and elegance, with a bright straw colour and lively bubbles. Apple and brioche lead the way in this medium bodied, fruity and classically biscuity style of Champagne.

APERITIF & DESSERT WINE

PEDRO XIMINEZ, NECTAR PX, GONZALEZ BYASS, JEREZ, SPAIN

Rich, sweet and velvety smooth, this is an extraordinary sherry. Complex flavours of mocha, figs, caramel, nuts and spices make this Pedro Ximinez a delicious indulgence that pairs equally well with desserts or a cheeseboard.

ROYAL TOKAJI LATE HARVEST, 2017 HUNGARY
