WHITE WINES			
1 THE OLD GUM TREE CHARDONNAY	£6.50	£9.20	£27
Named after Australia's iconic gum trees, this Chardonnay reflects the country's move towards fresher, more balanced styles. Sun-ripened stone fruit, melon and citrus are complemented by gentle oak, adding hints of vanilla and toasted nuts.			
2 CRESCENDO PINOT GRIGIO	£6.50	£9.20	£27
A fresh, modern Pinot Grigio shaped by cooling Adriatic breezes that help preserve its lively acidity and purity of fruit. Aromas of pear, green apple and white peach lead to a crisp, dry palate with subtle citrus notes.			
3 LES GARRAUDES SAUVIGNON BLANC	£6.50	£9.20	£27
A vibrant Sauvignon Blanc that showcases classic cool-climate freshness and aromatic lift. Notes of gooseberry, lime and fresh herbs are followed by a crisp palate with green apple and a subtle mineral edge. Named after a specific vineyard parcel, it reflects the French emphasis on terroir and precision.			
RED WINES			
21 BEAUTÉ DU SUD MALBEC	£6.50	£9.20	£27
A plush, expressive Malbec with a distinctly southern French character. Ripe blackberry and plum flavours are complemented by hints of spice and soft tannins. Smoother and more restrained than New World styles, it combines richness with elegance and easy drinkability.			
22 HILLVILLE ROAD SHIRAZ	£6.50	£9.20	£27
A classic Australian Shiraz showing ripe, generous fruit and smooth structure. Aromas of blackberry, plum and black pepper lead into a rich palate with subtle spice and soft tannins. Balanced and approachable, it reflects the warmth and fruit-forward style that has made Aussie Shiraz so popular.			
23 CONDE DE CASTILE CRIANZA	£6.50	£9.20	£27
A traditional Rioja Crianza offering a harmonious balance of fruit and oak ageing. Red cherry, raspberry and subtle vanilla notes come from time spent in oak barrels, while gentle tannins and fresh acidity give structure. A classic, food-friendly expression of Rioja's long winemaking heritage.			
ROSÉ WINE			
19 THE GUV'NOR ROSE	£6.50	£9.20	£27
This glorious Spanish pink breaks the regional restrictions to bring you plenty of flavour. It's a blend of Garnacha, Bobal and Tempranillo grapes. Each of these varieties comes from a different area and has a unique identity. Bring them all together, and you get something truly remarkable.

14 BEL CANTO PROSECCO			£30
A lively Prosecco designed to celebrate freshness and fruit purity. Aromas of green apple, pear and white flowers lead to a light, crisp palate with fine bubbles.

CHAMPAGNES

Bottle

The Cattier family's wine journey began as far back as 1625. Today, it's the 13th generation who uphold the traditions that they have inherited. The estate is surrounded by Premier and Grand Cru vineyards in the heart of Montagne de Reims. As well as creating premium brand Armand de Brignac, (known as Ace of Spades), the estate also owns a walled vineyard – Clos du Moulin – a claim that very few Champagne houses can boast. Cattier places special emphasis on Pinot Meunier, using a high proportion in all cuvées to produce rich, aromatic, fruit-forward Champagnes.

15 CATTIER PREMIER CRU NV

£70

A bit of a hidden gem for those in the know. Fresh, lively, and effortlessly elegant, with crisp apple, citrus, and a gentle hint of brioche. The bubbles are fine, the finish is clean, and it's dangerously easy to enjoy. A proper Champagne without the show-off price tag – which makes ordering a second bottle feel entirely reasonable.

16 PALMER & CO ROSÉ SOLERA NV

£80

An exceptional rosé champagne with fruity and delicately spicy aromas, ROSÉ SOLERA combines the great precision, freshness and fullness that are characteristic of the Palmer & Co style. Charming aromas of wild strawberries, red and black currants, combined with beautiful hints of vanilla and cinnamon spice.

17 BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE NV

£90

Champagne with a bit of swagger. Bollinger is rich, full-bodied, and unapologetically indulgent, with notes of ripe orchard fruit, brioche, and toasted nuts wrapped up in a fine, persistent fizz. Led by Pinot Noir, it's got depth, character, and just the right amount of decadence.

18 PALMER & CO BLANC DE BLANCS NV

£100

This Blanc de Blancs cuvée of incomparable purity is based on Chardonnay, mainly from the magnificent vineyards of Trépail and Villers-Marmery.

This crystalline champagne exudes subtle aromas of citrus fruit, white flowers and almonds. Fresh and silky on the palate, it unrolls with finesse on beautiful mineral notes that are typical of these chalky soils.

WHITE WINES	Bottle
4 DOMAINE REVERDY-DUCROUX SANCERRE	£48
Sancerre is widely regarded as one of France's most prestigious expressions of Sauvignon Blanc and this exceptional wine delivers everything you could want from this classic style. Mouth-Wateringly fresh with aromas of citrus, white peach, pear and a hint of white pepper. Its long, mineral finish makes it a perfect match for fresh white fish dishes.	
5 LOUIS LATOUR MACON LUGNY	£46
Unlike the northern Côtes, the southern part of Burgundy doesn't have a formalised vineyard hierarchy system, so the wines tend to be more wallet-friendly. Not to mention, Lugny is one of the best regarded villages in the Mâcon, and Latour is one of the most famous houses. This is a gently honeyed wine with notes of ripe peach and a crisp finish.	
6 DOMAINE DE L'ENCLOS CHABLIS	£48
This Chablis from the dynamic Bouchard brothers is bright with lifted fruit and waxy with a touch of lemon zest which gives way to a zesty creaminess on the palate. Unoaked and beautifully expressive, it shows why Domaine de L'Enclos is one of the most exciting new domaines in Chablis.	
7 CASTILLO MONJARDIN CHARDONNAY	£37
This unoaked Chardonnay from Navarra has a lovely inviting tropical fruit character on the nose, there is a delicious lick of citrus acidity to bring balance to the palate and the finish is clean and long.	
8 MONTGOMERY SOLARIS, WELSH WINE	£38
Montgomery is a family run vineyard in the heart of Montgomeryshire, Mid-Wales. Delicately handpicked from special parcels of Solaris vines and gently pressed. This signature wine offers aromas of pear drops with an exotic tropical nose. On tasting, refreshing grapefruit, overlaid with a delicate sweetness.	
9 NETTIE VIOGNIER	£35
Named 'Nettie' after Miss Nettie Valear who planted an acorn on the site of the now-vineyard in memory of Abraham Lincoln. Classic varieties like Viognier flourish in California. This wine is a case in point – it's full of character. It's big. It's lush. It's fruity. Full of peach and apricot flavours, with a really rich, round texture.	
10 LA TOLEDANA GAVI DI GAVI	£38
Elegant, understated, and quietly confident. This is crisp Italian white at its finest – fresh citrus, green apple, and a subtle almond note on the finish. Clean, mineral, and beautifully balanced, it's the kind of wine that doesn't shout for attention but absolutely deserves it. Effortlessly classy... and very easy to fall for.	
11 RAFAEL PALACIOUS LOURO GODELLO	£48
WHAT a wine! The 'Louro' is a straw colour with youthful highlights. It has intense aromas of citrus fruits, wild mountain flowers, hints of fennel and flinty nuances. On the palate, it is fruit-forward supported by a taut, saline minerality and a textural complexity.	
12 ELLA'S RIDGE SAUVIGNON BLANC	£37
Zingy, vibrant, and full of personality. Bursting with gooseberry, citrus, and a cheeky hint of tropical fruit, it's crisp, refreshing, and unapologetically lively. Exactly what you want from a Marlborough Sauvignon – bright, punchy, and dangerously easy to keep sipping. One glass has a habit of turning into two.	

RED WINES	Bottle
24 ZENSA PRIMATIVO IGP PUGLIA	£37
Quite simply a damned good bottle of red and organic to boot! In the mouth it is full-bodied yet smooth and elegant with a silky texture. The finish is long and lingering, with a burst of spiced cherries and bright fruit and earthiness at the end.	
25 CĂLUSARI PINOT NOIR	£35
The Calusari were apparently a Romanian secret society who were known for their ability to create the impression of flying through the air; apparently this could cure the victims of fairies! Anyway, this Pinot is a fantastic little number that we absolutely love; velvety smooth and delicately balanced, tobacco and black cherry on the nose promises the shape of things to come, juicy berries and a depth hard to beat in this price range. It could almost cure the victims of fairies...	
26 CHATEAU MAHON-LAVILLE	£40
A deep purple claret that offers concentrated plum and spice from the Merlot, alongside minerality that is typical of this region. A powerful but smooth palate, with the Cabernet Sauvignon adding firm tannins and fine structure to the finish.	
27 CONSOLATION WILD BOAR SYRAH	£56
Consolation is a range of wines made by Andy Cook, a deracinated Englishman now living with his family in Collioure. He only makes two or three barrels of each wine (around 50-75 cases) so quantities are limited, but what the wines lack for in quantity they make up for in quality. Last year the wild boar ate 50% of the crop in this lovely vineyard surrounded by cypress trees. Inky colour, earthy and a touch minty with intense black fruit, fairly soft tannins: definitely full bodied, big and rich, combining savoury and sweet, very ripe fruit, altogether delicious.	
28 AGRICOLA DE CADALSO GARNACHA	£50
A truly stunning wine from Madrid. Pale red with an intense mineral character, its aromas of red fruits of the forest mix with notes of scrubland in the nose. It has mature tannins and is easy to drink, with a taste embellished by aromas of plums and charcoal giving it a delicate and personal character.	
29 HENRI EHRHART '18 MOIS' PINOT NOIR	£42
A noble grape par excellence, the Pinot Noir produced by Maison Ehrhart requires rigor and controlled production. In the Alsatian climate, it produces a lively and fruity wine with a sparkling ruby colour, to meet the demand for a supple red wine with soft, silky tannins.	
30 WISDOM TREE DAO TINTO	£35
Soft, smooth, and quietly impressive. Packed with ripe plum and bramble fruit, with a gentle lift of herbs and a touch of warming spice on the finish. Silky, well-balanced, and effortlessly drinkable – the kind of red that doesn't make a fuss, but always delivers. A proper crowd-pleaser that keeps you coming back for another glass.	
31 ALLEGRIINI, PALAZZO DELLA TORRE	£50
A mind-blowingly good wine! Ruby red in colour, Palazzo della Torre has enticing aromas of cherry with rich dark chocolate notes. Velvety in texture, it is well-balanced and offers ripe, juicy dark fruit, with silky tannins and refreshing acidity.

32 JOURNEY'S END SHIRAZ

£36

In 1995 the Gabb family, originally from Shropshire, fell in love with this picturesque wine farm surrounded by 20 hectares of gorgeous vineyards. A big, soft-hearted, enjoyable wine, plenty of ripe Shiraz fruit with loads of character on the palate and a full flavoured finish.

33 ESPIRIT DE LUSSAC, LUSSAC ST-EMILION

£40

Lussac is one of five villages to the northeast of St-Emilion with the right to add that name to their own. Lussac makes excellent 'satellite' wines, slightly more rustic than its big brother, but rounded and with great charm. This is a full bodied and rich wine, showing great concentration of flavour from the Merlot grapes. With juicy blackberry and blackcurrant fruit on the nose, backed up with a palate of smoky sandalwood.

34 GHOST IN THE MACHINE CABERNET FRANC

£45

Bruce Jack's Wines are all about pushing the experimental boundaries of winemaking. A burst of dark red fruits, blackberry, blackcurrant, canned peas, savoury notes and molasses or toffee. The palate of dark red fruit follows through with a smokey, herbaceous finish.

35 MASSAYA 'LE COLOMBIER'

£40

The history of Lebanon is brutal and aggressive, thankfully in all that mayhem winemakers flourish. Spicy notes with ripe, meaty, blackberry and red fruits, and a touch of chocolate. This supple, round wine is from an exciting French-Lebanese collaboration, which owns vineyards at an altitude of 1,000 metres in the Bekaa Valley.

36 BEDOBA, SAPERAVI

£40

Made from the indigenous Georgian variety Saperavi, partially vinified in traditional qvevri vessels, Bedoba translates to 'Day of Luck'. Bedoba's Saperavi grapes hail from vines with an average age of 30 years old. These are planted in the renowned wine region of Kakheti (near the eastern border with Azerbaijan) in the Kvareli and Kindzmarauli appellations along the Duruji River valley. This wine is dark purple in colour. The nose opens with a powerful savoury-spicy bouquet of blackberries, herbs, flowers and black pepper. The palate has a creamy, juicy texture, ripe tannins and black fruit flavours. A truly spectacular and very moreish wine!

ROSÉ WINES

19 THE GUV'NOR ROSE

£27

This glorious Spanish pink breaks the regional restrictions to bring you plenty of flavour. It's a blend of Garnacha, Bobal and Tempranillo grapes. Each of these varieties comes from a different area and has a unique identity. Bring them all together, and you get something truly remarkable.

20 HENRI ERHART ROSÉ

£40

Henri Ehrhart Rosé Reserve Pinot Noir is a delicate and refreshing rosé from Alsace, made from Pinot Noir grapes. At 12.5% ABV, it has a soft pink hue and an aroma of red berries, white flowers, and a hint of citrus.

The palate is crisp and elegant, featuring flavours of strawberries, watermelon, and a clean, dry finish.

CHATEAU LE FAGÉ MONTBAZILAC 375ml Bottle £29

“Pudding wines” are often a bit of an overlooked afterthought but can be the most pleasurable part of the meal. A fresh, lively and aromatic sweet wine with a complex nose, unctuous and warm on the palate, with attractive flavours of quince, orange peel, hazelnuts, walnuts and dried figs.

DOMAINE LAFAGE MAURY GRENAT LANGUEDOC 500ml Bottle £34

This is a deliciously sweet red wine. Full-bodied and rich, with intense flavours and aromas of dried red fruits, chocolate and coffee. It is historically good!
