| 01. <b>Hermitage Blanc, Chante-Alouette, M. Chapoutier</b><br><b>France</b><br>Made from 100% Marsanne hand-harvested from three different vineyard sites, all with different soil types give wonderful complexity to this wine. One third of the wine is vinified in wooden barrels with regular stirring. The wine is then aged for 10 to 12 months before bottling. Green-gold in colour, the nose is complex and subtle with aromas of quince, walnut, honey, ginger and acacia. On the palate you can feel the minerality and weight. | 02. <b>Hartford Court Stone Côte Chardonnay 2012,</b><br><b>Sonoma County, California, USA</b><br>The Stone Côte Vineyard is a small vineyard block which sits upon an ancient riverbed at the southern end of the Sonoma Coast AVA. Climatically, this vineyard site is characterized by relatively cool daytime temperatures and maritime breezes, which marry with the low-fertility soils to create an ideal site for growing Chardonnay. This single-vineyard bottling, fermented with indigenous yeast, exhibits notes of white peach, orange blossom, hazelnut and honeysuckle which are perfectly married to the flinty aromas. It is medium to full bodied with a gorgeously mineral-laden, textured personality and great length. | 03. <b>Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru Sous le Puits,</b><br><b>Remoissenet et fils, Burgundy, France</b><br>Founded in 1877, Remoissenet Père et Fils was run for most of the last one hundred years from a 14th Century building in Beaune. Claudie Jobard has been the head winemaker here since 2005 and was inspired by her mother, Laurence, who was the head winemaker at the famed Joseph Druhin for 30 years; so a great deal of passion and heritage.<br><br>The vineyard of Sous les Puits can be found in the far north-west corner of the appellation, near the hamlet of Blagny; is situated quite high on the slope and usually produces bright, fresh wines for which the house is famous.. The wines benefit from the house's policy of picking late, by exhibiting both a piercing minerality and ripe fruit flavours. It is aged for 16 months in 40% new French Oak barrels. | 2013    | 25.00          | 125.00 |
| 04. <b>Meursault 1er Cru Genevrières Domaine Henri Boillot</b><br><b>Burgundy, France</b><br>This Henri Boillot Meursault comes from one of the area's larger and better-known premier cru vineyards, Genevrières. Expect pure aromas of soft citrus and stone fruits, buttery hazelnut and spices, balanced by fine, mineral acidity. This 2013 exhibits Boillot's textbook luxurious, velvety richness and fruit depth whilst finishing long and perfumed on the palate.  | 2013    | 29.00          | 145.00 |

05. **Pouilly Fume Blanc, Silex, Didier Dageuneau, Loire France** 2014 35.00 175.00

The term 'Legend' is perhaps marginally overused in the wine world, however few would argue against placing Didier Dageuneau in this esteemed bracket. Didier was the man behind some of the world's most iconic, complex Sauvignon Blanc's from the Pouilly Fumé appellation in the Loire. Since his tragic death in 2008, his son Benjamin has continued his legacy, crafting wines of extraordinary character and acclaim.

'Silex' is the French for flint, a dominant component of Dagenau's limestone rich vineyard soils. Unusually, the wine is fermented and aged in oak demi muids barrels which lends added texture and complexity.

The 2014 Silex does smell palpably of flint and herbs and zesty citrus notes, while on the palate there are notes of lime juice, apple blossom, struck flint and fine lemon garlanding a firm, almost spicy mineral core. This is a true gem, both incredibly intense but also exceptionally well balanced. Stunning!

06. **Bâtard-Montrachet Grand Cru, Louis Jadot, France** 2011 59.00 295.00

The most full-bodied of the Grand Crus of Puligny and Chassagne. This wine is fermented and aged for an average of 18 months in oak barrels before bottling. The wine starts with intense aromas and flavours of almonds, apple, white flowers and spices. It has a sumptuous richness, great concentration, a stunning intensity and incredible length. (2011 Vintage: 95 points Wine Spectator).

| 07. <b>Corton-Pougets Grand Cru, Domaine des Héritiers Louis Jadot, France</b><br>The Grand Cru vineyard of Les Pougets is made up of two parcels covering ten hectares on the upper and mid-slope next to the Le Charlemagne 'climat'. Jadot owns a superb, southerly-exposed parcel of about 1.5 hectares purchased in 1914. This exceptional site yields pure, mineral wines with red fruits and firm tannins. With age they become more expressive and more attractive, showing seductive layers of berry and oak. The 2006 started life beautifully balanced but slightly austere in comparison to the 2005. It has now developed into a wine with a combination of refinement and complexity. It shows a touch of spice and forest floor that merges into the intense and mineral-infused medium-bodied fruit flavours, culminating in an impressively long finish. | 2006    | 24.00          | 122.00 |
| 08. <b>Hermitage, Monier de la Sizeranne, M. Chapoutier France</b><br>From the Rhône's smallest appellation, this wine is a blend of Syrah grapes hand-harvested from different vineyard sites, including Le Méal and Les Greffieux. Fermented in concrete tanks with one to two daily treadings to ensure a good extraction, it is then aged in oak casks for 12 to 14 months. The wine is a deep garnet-red, with purplish lights. It shows raspberry and blackcurrant aromas with a hint of liquorice and spicy, black pepper. Round and elegant in the mouth, the wine has concentrated dark and red fruits with gentle tannins followed by a lingering fresh finish.   | 2011/12 | 25.00          | 124.00 |
| 09. <b>Sassicaia Tenuta San Guido, Bolgheri DOC, Italy</b><br>A landmark Italian wine created by the Marchese Mario Incisa della Rocchetta based on the finest wines of Bordeaux. 85% Cabernet Sauvignon and 15% Cabernet Franc, from vineyards on the Tuscan coast near Livorno. The wine is fermented in stainless steel before 24 months ageing in French oak barrique. It has ripe black cherry and blackberry flavours with accents of rosemary, mineral and spice. 10. **Château Palmer 2001, Margaux, Bordeaux, France** 2001 57.00 285.00

Chateau Palmer is a powerhouse of Bordeaux's Margaux appellation. Indeed, situated right next door to Chateau Margaux itself, some critics believe that Palmer is often capable of outperforming its iconic neighbour.

The 2001 exhibits the classically elegant Palmer nose; some richness, but always remaining pure and delicate. There's a Cabernet Sauvignon backbone (51%) yet more Merlot in the blend than usual (44%) and Petit Verdot (5%), perhaps one reason it's less powerful and more subtle and generous than other vintages. The 2001 offers scents of red fruit, blackberry, sandalwood, spice, and mocha and follows through in a similar fashion on the palate; poise, precision and finesse!

The 2001 vintage is today a highly sought-after, scarce find on the Fine Wine Market and is quite simply described by the Chateau themselves as - 'Pure Palmer'.

11. **Opus One 2010, Oakville, Napa, California, USA** 2007 80.00 400.00

The 2010 Opus One is an absolutely sensational wine. It brings intoxicating aromas of ripe blackberries and dark currant fruit followed by Asian spices, herbs and graphite which weave their way through the wine. It has a wonderful silky texture that is well structured, demonstrating remarkable depth and balance. Everything is wrapped up with a long lingering finish that leaves behind flavours of graphite and dark fruits (Vintage 2010: 96 points Robert Parker, Wine Advocate).

12. **Château Mouton Rothschild 2004, Pauillac, Bordeaux France** 2004 100.00 475.00

Château Mouton Rothschild is one of the five Classified First Growths of Bordeaux, a status it acquired, after years of lobbying, in 1973. The estate consistently produces wines of unquestionable quality and finesse. A blend of Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, the wine exhibits beautiful aromas of crushed berries and chocolate, with hints of Indian spices. Full-bodied, with silky, velvety tannins and a long, caressing finish. This is a truly iconic wine and one we are extremely proud to be able to offer as part of our Coravin range. (Vintage 2004: 18 points Jancis Robinson).
