12. PINOTAGE, STILL BAY, SOUTH AFRICA £5.15 £6.60 £18.50 Soft, smoky flavours with plum & cherry fruit, a great example of Pinotage.

13. MALBEC, GOYENECHEA, ARGENTINA £5.60 £7.40 £19.50 Plum red colour. Delicate nose, dry fruits, walnut, lightly spiced. Well combined smoked wood. Soft and fruity with little tannin. Good blackberry flavour

14. SHIRAZ, COORONG ESTATE, AUSTRALIA £5.15 £6.65 £18.50 Spicy blackberry & plum flavours on the palate are followed by a long smooth finish.

15. RIOJA CRIANZA, VINA AMATE, SPAIN **£5.60 £7.40 £19.50** Aged in American oak for 12 months with 12 months in the bottle, creating a soft & smooth Rioja with hints of vanilla & chocolate.
